I hope everyone is patiently enduring these cold, snowy days! Hopefully we will see signs of spring soon.

I know that our parish has experienced several changes over the last few months. I am reminded of the quote, "nothing is for certain, except change" As you know we became a one-priest parish rather abruptly and I made changes quickly as a response during that time. After prayer and discernment, I have had time to reflect on how to meet the needs of our parish when it comes to receiving the Sacraments.

Beginning the week of March 7th, we will have daily Mass on Monday, Tuesday, Thursday and Friday at 9AM. There will be an evening Mass every Wednesday at 6PM. Please note as of March 7th we will no longer have a Wednesday morning Mass.

Eucharistic Adoration will be moved to Wednesdays with exposition beginning at 930AM and conclude with benediction at 545PM with Mass immediately following.

Confessions will be offered Monday and Friday from 515 to 6PM and Saturdays from 9 to 10AM.

I realize that change may be difficult especially with the way we had to adapt with the recent changes at SJN, but now I feel at peace with this current schedule. I hope that it will appeal to many of you and more people will have their daily and weekly sacramental needs met as I try to offer as many opportunities as I can given our new schedule.

Please continue to pray for our parish and the Universal Church as we navigate these challenging times.
