Consider being an Edge Core leader. You are given the necessary support and materials. You will meet some truly wonderful kids from our parish, learn new things about the Catholic faith and grow in your own faith. As an Edge Core leader, you don't teach the

lesson, but you do help to facilitate a question and answer session during the small group component of the evening. Each group has an average of 8-10 kids and two Core leaders (usually one adult and one teen). This experience can be extremely rewarding, and I am confident that you will walk away feeling that you have received so much more than you have given. I first became involved with the EDGE program when my teen daughter asked me to lead an EDGE group with her. I definitely could not say no to such a request! We had such a wonderful experience together. This fall I will be starting my fifth year as an adult leader with the program and my third year that I will be leading a group with my son. I have thoroughly enjoyed all my time with this group. It has been such a blessing to have Monday nights set aside as a time I get to spend with my child. I watched both my children grow and mature so much as teen leaders in the EDGE program. It has been so rewarding to see them change from timid and quiet participants to confident leaders. We have learned so much together and I am so happy that they found a way to remain involved in the church. I was initially nervous to volunteer because I didn't feel as though I had all the skills needed to teach or lead a religious program. I soon found out that this program is so well run and is very fun. It's amazing how much laughter and enjoyment we have had from these middle school kids! 
