We also assembled a multi-trauma medical bag. He will collect general information including names, medical experience & contact information. In the near future, a brief orientation will be held to discuss and plan the most efficient use of our resources in the event of a medical emergency.

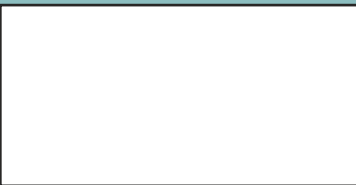
