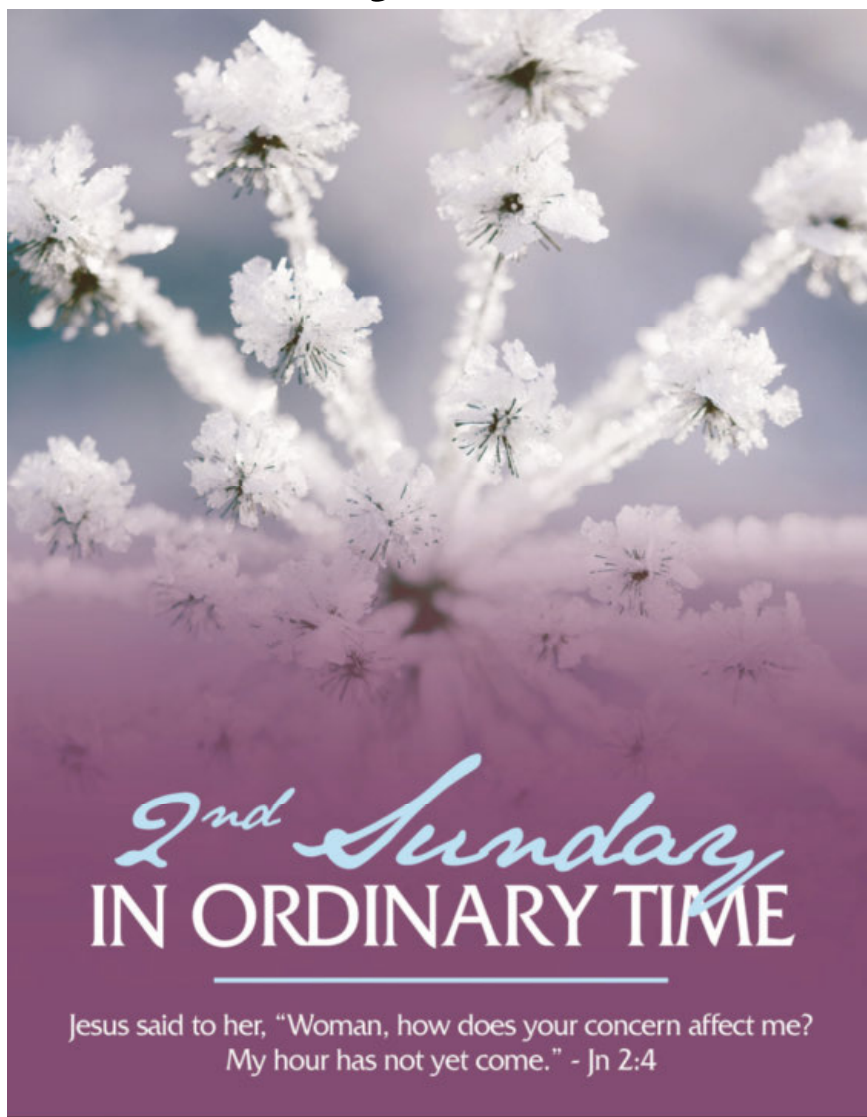

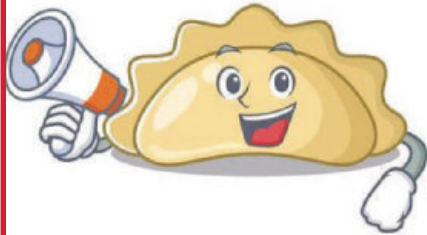

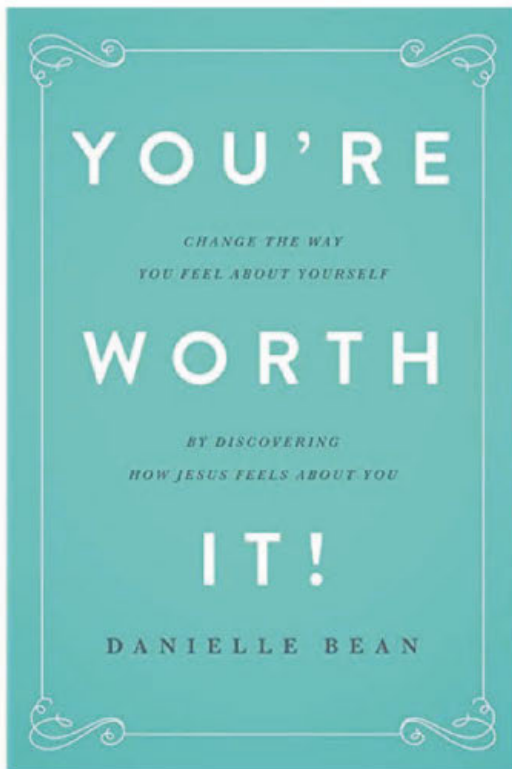
Ladies Wednesday Night Retreats

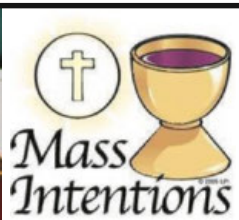
We will begin the retreat January 12 and run every Wednesday ending February 23. 6:30-7:30 PM. One hour once a week for 7 weeks, you can do this!

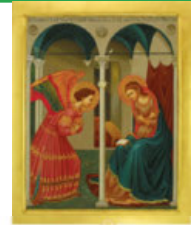


Second Sunday in Ordinary Time
