SACRAMENTAL CARE OF THE SICK AND HOMEBOUND

(1) Holy Communion is brought to the sick monthly. (2) Sacrament of Anointing (Extreme Unction), or if someone is in the hospital and should be visited, please contact the Rectory.

LETTERS OF RECOMMENDATION

The requirements for Sponsors of Baptism and Confirmation are the following: (1) Have received the three Sacraments of Initiation (Baptism, Confirmation and the Eucharist). (2) If married, the marriage must conform to the regulations of the Catholic Church. (3) Attend Mass every Sunday. (4) Receive Communion on a regular basis. (5) If you have children, they must be attending Religious Education classes or be enrolled in Catholic School. (6) Be a registered Parishioner. Young Adults who have recently been confirmed and are working, even part-time, should assume their own identity in the Parish by registering in their own name.

SACRAMENT OF MARRIAGE

Requests for weddings should be made at least six to twelve months in advance of the prospective date. Church arrangements should be made before other wedding date commitments. <u>NO</u> wedding dates are given over the phone. Pre-marriage preparation is also required.

The Rectory Office is OPEN by Appointment ONLY.
