





The winter weather is on its way. We want our parishioners, friends, staff and our clergy to be safe this winter season. Our family has decided on the following in case of inclement weather.

We will follow the guidelines set by the City of Buffalo for winter weather, (driving ban etc.)

If there is a **driving ban** in the City of Buffalo there will be <u>no services</u> and <u>parish</u> <u>offices will be closed</u>, including St. John Gualbert in Cheektowaga.

We will also follow the Buffalo Schools winter weather closures. If **Buffalo schools** are closed due to winter weather, there will be <u>no services</u> and <u>parish offices</u> will be closed, including St. John Gualbert in Cheektowaga.

Closings will be listed on Channel 4 -WIVB.com as "Greater East Buffalo Family of Parishes." *Please be assured, the Mass intentions during driving bans and school closures will be fulfilled by our priests in their residence chapels.*

**17**: Catholic Charities Kinship Caregiver Program is a resource for non-parents who may need support in stepping out of the relative role and into that of a parent.
