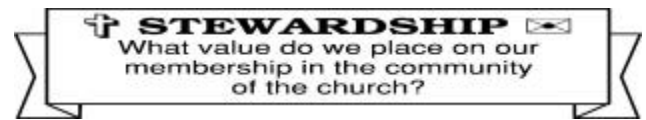

These feasts include: All Saint's Day, Christmas, Mary's Immaculate Conception, Easter, Christ's Ascension and the Assumption of Mary into Heaven. All Sundays– in honor of Easter Sunday– are also holy days of obligation for the same reasons.
