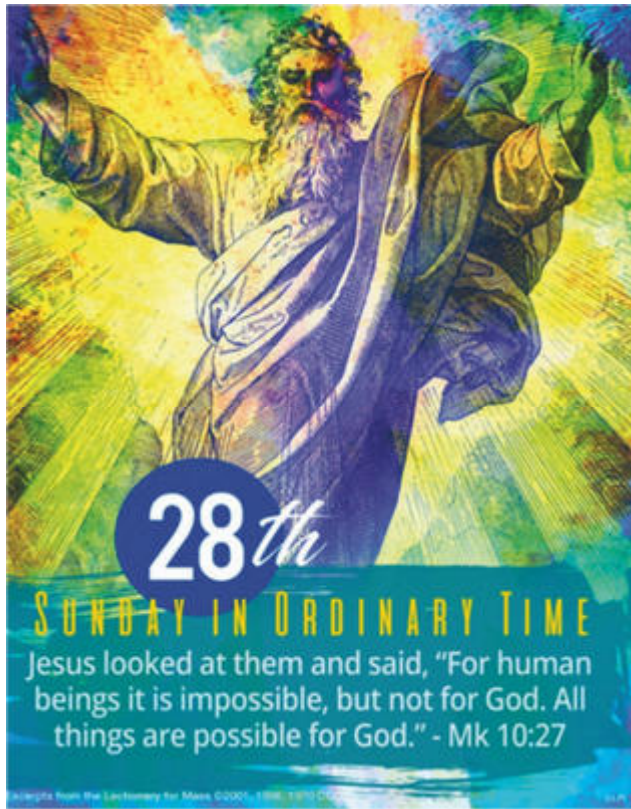

Greetings of Peace. This week we begin **mid-October**. Time flies. In a couple of weeks we will "spin the clocks" back an hour. As I have previously said, our weather is "up and down" this time of year. One day it is warm and the next it is cool, or cold! We will try our best to make the temperature in the church and parish facilities is consistent with the weather. One day we might need A/C and the next day we will need the heat. We will do our best to make the temperature of our worship space comfortable during the change of seasons. Soon we will need the heat and

turn off the A/C until spring! Enjoy the beautiful weather, colors of the foliage, and the gift of changing seasons!

This weekend we share with the parish our **Annual Finance Report**. Our fiscal year goes from July 1 to June 30 and we recently "closed the books" on the 2020-21 fiscal year. Thank you for your generous support of our parish and its ministries. Our Parish Staff and Finance Council all seek to be good stewards of your generosity and the report this weekend will highlight some areas and share some ongoing needs. The pandemic we have faced these past 18 months has not helped matters any! Again, we are so grateful for your continued support of St. Joan of Arc Parish. Thank you Thank you!!

Some may have noticed the **statues of Mary and St. Joseph** are not "up" in the front of the church, now. No, they were not kidnapped! A couple of weeks ago we discovered a problem with the base/pedestals for both statues – and Joseph was beginning to lean forward noticeably. Of course, we do not want either statue to fall or break. More importantly, we do not want a statue to fall on someone. So, for now, the statues are taken down.

We are looking at the best way to address this situation and considering various options. The "Holy Family Shrine" is a beautiful part of our church building and we anticipate having the statues back up "in due time."

As I wrote last week, **we have entered "Cold and Flu Season."** Let's look out for each other and our well-being. Those that are ill should please stay home when sick. It is also prudent to avoid close contact with people who are sick, or if you are sick. "Cover up" with tissue or handkerchief when coughing or sneezing. Wash hands often. Get the flu shot.

In church we could share the Sign of Peace without touching – we could reverently bow of to one another. All are encouraged to receive Holy Communion in the hand, not on the tongue. Pray for those that are sick or dealing with serious illnesses.

All this is very appropriate – especially since **we are still in this CoVid Pandemic**. Wearing masks is also a very good thing as we seek to stay well and to look out for each other. Bishop Malesic has asked that everyone wear a face mask at mass and at gatherings at the parish. All should feel safe at our parishes and facilities. And all are encouraged to get the CoVid vaccine.

Finally, please note: **I will be away from the parish this week and next week – from Sunday October 10 through Saturday October 23**, returning for confessions and mass. In my absence, there will not be daily mass at the parish. Our neighboring priests will do their best to assist with any sacramental needs or emergencies that may present themselves. Our Parish Ministerial Staff will respond and assist as well. I will remember you in my prayer when I am away. Part of this time is for my annual retreat. Please pray for me. Thank you.
