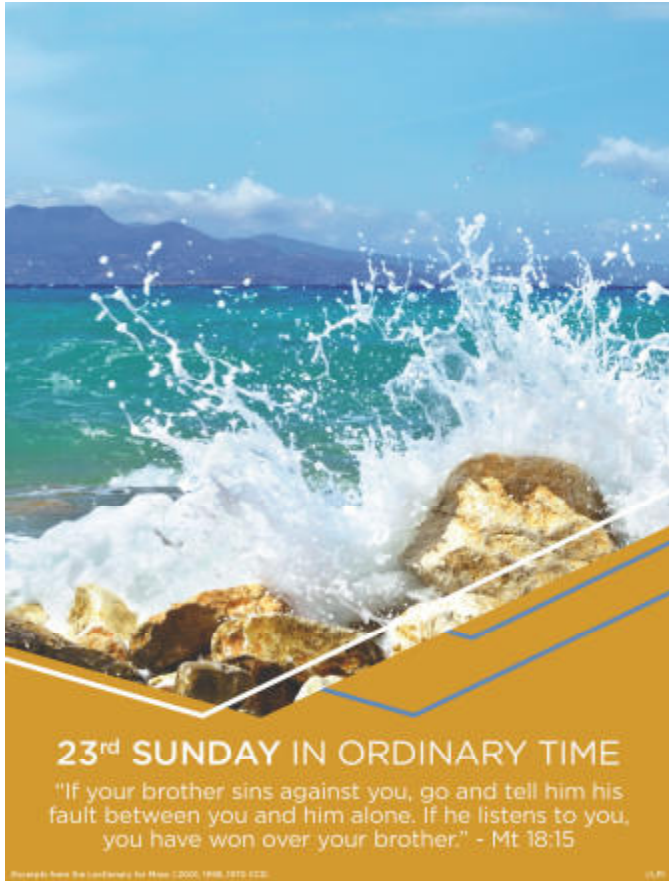

**CONFESSIONS:** Thurs. after Mass, Sat. 12–1 p.m. or by appointment

**BAPTISM:** Contact the pastor/associate to schedule baptism of infants and young children. RCIC /RCIA are for older children and adults.

**MATRIMONY:** A meeting with the priest/deacon is required before your wedding is scheduled. Preparation begins 6–12 months prior to the anticipated wedding date.

**PREPARATION FOR FIRST EUCHARIST AND CONFIRMATION** takes place over a two year period. Regular attendance at religious education classes is anticipated.

**If you have been asked to be a GODPARENT OR SPONSOR** for Baptism or Confirmation, forms are issued to parishioners baptized, confirmed, and registered at least six months. They should attend Mass regularly and if married, in conformity with the Church.

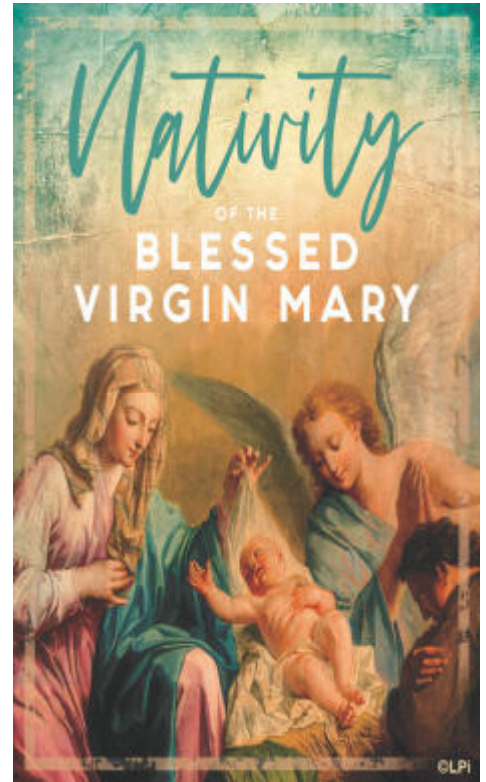

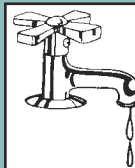
