CONFESSIONS: Thurs. after Mass, Sat. 12–1 p.m. or by appointment

BAPTISM: Contact the pastor/associate to schedule baptism of infants and young children. RCIC /RCIA are for older children and adults.

MATRIMONY: A meeting with the priest/deacon is required before your wedding is scheduled. Preparation begins 6–12 months prior to the anticipated wedding date.

PREPARATION FOR FIRST EUCHARIST AND CONFIRMATION takes place over a two year period. Regular attendance at religious education classes is anticipated.

If you have been asked to be a GODPARENT OR SPONSOR for Baptism or Confirmation, forms are issued to parishioners baptized, confirmed, and registered at least six months. They should attend Mass regularly and if married, in conformity with the Church.
