Looking for a New Year's Resolution?



Our 89 Day Parish Gospel Challenge Starts January 18th!

Many of us at one time or another have sat down with a Bible in our hands, randomly flipping through the pages wondering, "Where in the world do I begin?" Have you ever read all the Gospels? There are four Gospels: Matthew, Mark, Luke and John. All together they total 89 chapters of the bible (Matthew has 28, Mark has 16, Luke has 24 and John has 21). Can you challenge yourself to read just ONE chapter of the Gospel every day for 89 days? Take the 89 Day Parish Gospel Challenge! Clear your mind, quiet your heart, rest your soul and walk with Jesus as you read one chapter a day. Taking the

time to read and study God's Word is one of the greatest investments you will ever make.

Here are some useful tips for the challenge:

- 1. **Set aside time.** Purposely dedicate a time to spend with God each day. Put it on your calendar and treat it like an appointment you simply cannot miss.
- 2. **Find your reading spot**. Choose a comfortable place to read where you can be away from distractions.
- 3. Prepare your heart, mind and soul. Begin with a prayer and ask the Holy Spirit to teach you as you read and study.
- Determine to be focused. Silence your phone and wait until you are finished to respond to emails and texts.
- Stick with it. Consistency is the key. It is only a chapter a day.

We will begin the challenge on January 18th. Your 89th day will take you to Holy Saturday, April 16th. What a triumphal way to celebrate Easter Sunday this year.

89 Day Parish Gospel Challenge: Faith Formation Session #1: Consider attending a special one hour faith formation session on Wednesday, January 26th at 1:00 PM in School Meeting **Room 1.** In addition to reading the Scriptures let's take some time to also study them. 
