RCIA: The Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults is the process of welcoming new members into the Catholic faith. If you are interested in becoming a Catholic or completing your initiation into the Catholic Church, please call the pastor. BAPTISM: Parents are asked to attend an information and faith enrichment session before scheduling the baptism of their first child. Sessions are held in February, June & October. The Sacrament of Baptism is celebrated on the second Sunday of the month at 1:00PM. Arrangements can be made by calling the parish office.

MARRIAGE: Please contact the pastor to make arrangements for your wedding before any other arrangements are made. Diocesan policy requires at least a six month notification in order to complete the necessary preparation.

HOSPITAL & NURSING HOME VISITATION WITH COMMUNION: Please notify the parish office if you will be hospitalized or require an extended stay at a nursing facility.



Blessing of Throats Next Weekend



The blessing of throats will be conferred after all Masses next weekend, January 29th & 30th, in honor of the Feast of St. Blaise.

St. Blaise, a bishop in modern Turkey, was martyred around AD316. The blessing of throats associated with him is due to a

miracle attributed to him. While in prison, he miraculously saved a boy choking on a fish bone. Early in the 6th century, evidence exists in the Eastern Church that Blaise was prayed to for aliments of the throat. St. Blaise is a constant reminder of God's care and concern in our weakness and sickness.
