Dear Parishioners,

This letter from Archbishop Aymond is one that I am sure he never thought he would have to write when he became a priest. At the Convocation for priests that was held two weeks ago, you could feel the pain he was going through and the pain and embarrassment of the priests of the Archdiocese who gathered with him. It is a time, that for a Catholic, is difficult to turn on the news or read the paper.

In all of this it is important to remember the complaint of the Pharisees who claimed that Jesus welcomed sinner and ate with them. The responses of Jesus were the Parables of Mercy in Luke 15 -the lost sheep, the lost coin and the Prodigal Son. The sexual abuse scandal really does test our belief in the forgiveness and mercy of our God. We can easily believe that many of the sins we commit are forgiven because in reality we don't see them as all that terrible. But what about when the sin wounds so deeply and is also a crime. What about the people who covered up the sin and crime out of embarrassment or false loyalty. It is here that the test of our belief is challenged.

Each Sunday we come together and proclaim "Lord I am not worthy to have you come under my roof, but only say the word and my soul shall be healed". We pray this day that the manna, that is Jesus, will sustain us as a people of faith in this valley of tears.

Dear Sisters and Brothers in Christ:

In this week's Clarion Herald, which you will receive after Mass, I have specific initial steps we as bishops are taking to address the seriousness of sexual abuse.

We continue to experience deep sorrow for the victims and survivors of abuse by the church leaders. This is a time of prayer for their healing and asking God to help us purify the church.

Jesus reminds us that sometimes prayer and fasting are needed for true healing (*Mark 9:29*). I invite you to consider joining me in prayer and fasting each Friday from now through December 2018.

Some may ask, "Why should I pray and fast? I am not at fault". While this is true, we remember the words of St. Paul: "If one member suffers, all members suffer; if one member is honored, all members share its joy" (Corinthians 12:26).

Fasting and prayer on Fridays is a way we can be in solidarity with those who have been abused, to pray for their healing and to ask the Holy Spirit to lead our church to renewal. Fasting can be abstaining from food or any other sacrifice, for example spending less time on social media or humbly doing something or someone to show charity.

Once again, in the name of church leaders, I am sorry for the pain of those who have been hurt and for the disappointment of the people of God in our leadership as bishops.

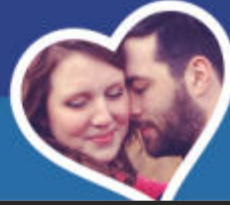
