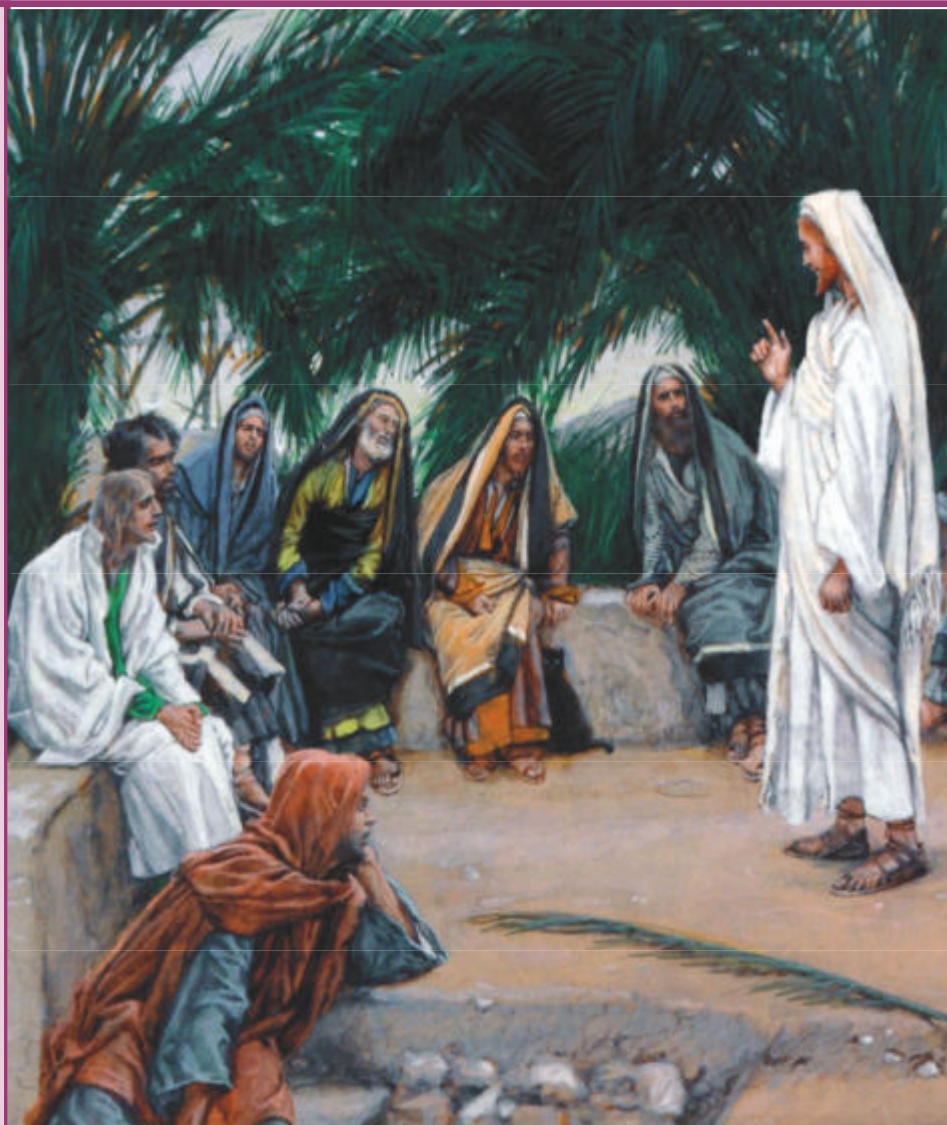

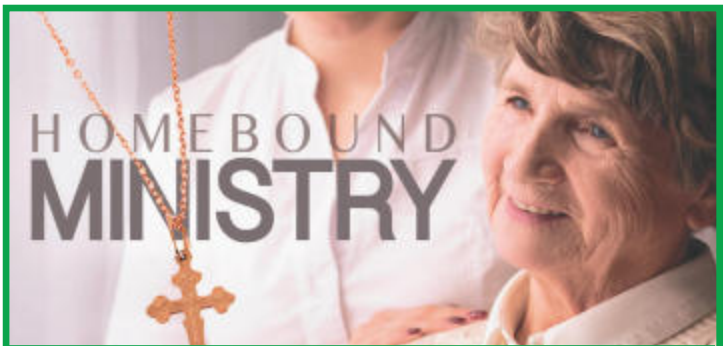
The Archdiocese of New Orleans has Catholic Counselling Service available to anyone who is in need of counselling. Call 504-861-6245 for more information .

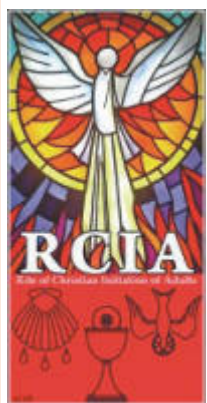
