

Congratulations to our May Queen Sierra Guimaraes– Thank You for helping to honor Our Lady in her month of May.

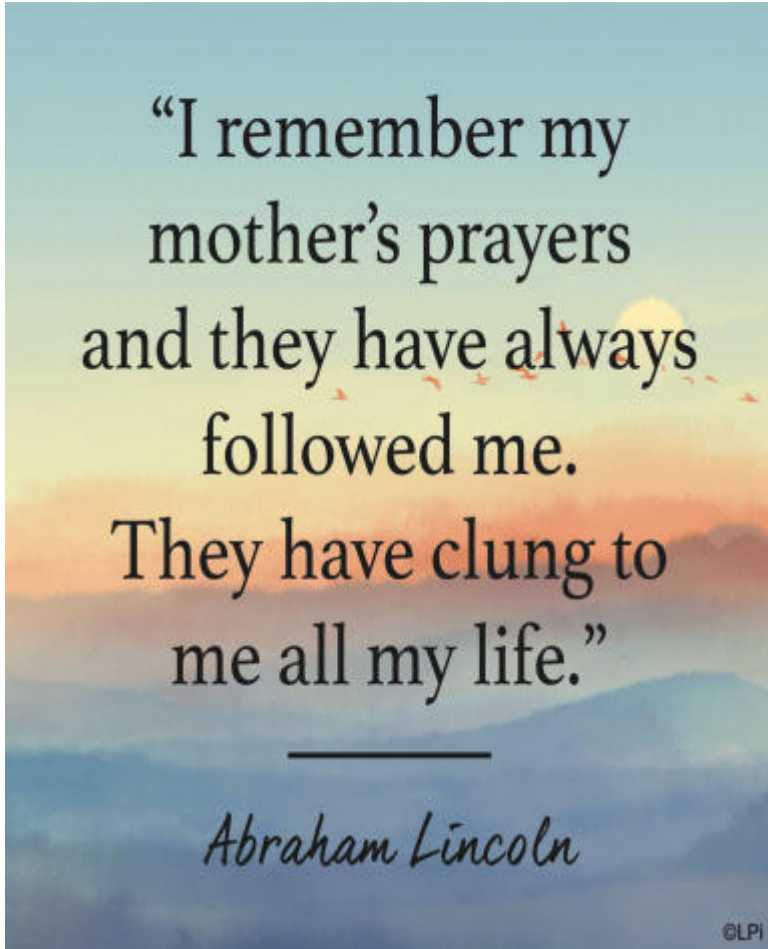

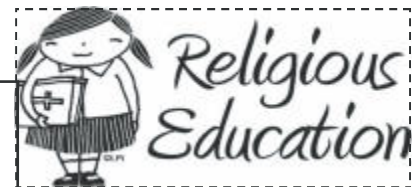

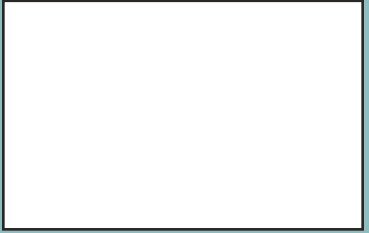
