**PASTOR'S COLUMN****MEN'S VIRTUAL LENTEN RETREAT – RISE**

This weekend men from our Frassati Men's Group will be speaking at all the Masses regrading a virtual retreat that they participated in this past December. For many they were wondering why they had not been told all this before regarding their roles as men, and especially as Catholic men. Everyone who participated could not say enough about the experience and the process that is involved. It was all easy to access. They participated as they were able. Now we are opening the retreat experience to all men in the parish, 18 years of age and up. It is suggested that every participant should have a "brother" to speak to each day, if only for a brief moment, regarding the daily 5-10 minute RISE video clip. That "brother" could be chosen by the participant, or if interested, we could assign one. Some, however, decided not to have a "brother" and do it on their own – not recommended, but possible. Everyone participated either on zoom or in-person for a small group chat each week about the week's progress and what was most impactful for that week, if anything. This retreat was well worth the price of \$32 for the 30 days it took to complete it. Usually a one day, in-person "day of reflection" at a retreat house is around \$100-\$200. This retreat would make Lent, even better. It is also conducive to our COVID restrictions and levels of comfort. In this Year of St. Joseph, this is the call for all men of the parish to RISE this Lent.

**CALLED FOR MORE – PARISH SURVEY**

The Diocese of Cleveland has been asked to pilot a new program from the Catholic Leadership Institute (CLI). The program is entitled, "Called for More." One of the goals is to seek improvement in a parish community regarding discipleship growth and development. All parishes in the diocese are participating. St. Brendan needs your help! There is a 10-15 minute online survey that will be available through our parish website beginning on February 20 and will close on March 21. Paper copies will be made available as well that would have to be sent into the parish office through mail or through dropping them in the special basket at church, marked "SURVEYS." The surveys will also be available in the Red Box outside of the school.

- **WHAT'S IN THE SURVEY?**

The survey will ask you to reflect on your own spiritual growth and enable you to provide feedback on our parish's efforts to help you grow. All responses will be confidential, and the parish staff and I will only receive from CLI information on the parish as a whole.

- **WHO DOES THE SURVEY?**

As the pastor, I had to take an extensive (45 minute) personal survey of my own priestly ministry. I then asked Parish Pastoral Council to take a survey that was designed with them in mind regarding their experience of the parish. That took about 20-25 minutes. Now it is up to every parishioner, who is able, to respond. The survey will take 10-15 minutes of your time. We need as much participation from those who are parishioners as possible. Please do the survey. You would, in the long run, be helping me and the parish as a whole by participating.

- **WHAT'S NEXT WITH THE SURVEY?**

Look for the survey beginning on February 20 on our parish website or the paper copy after Mass on that weekend. The information that everyone provides will help us plan for the future and strive to be the best disciples we can be. We will receive the results this spring/summer at which time I will share what we have learned with the entire parish. Thank you for helping with this important project.






