THE YEAR OF SAINT JOSEPH

(DECEMBER 8, 2020-DECEMBER 8, 2021)

A tender and loving father

In the synagogue, during the praying of the Psalms, Joseph would surely have heard again and again that the God of Israel is a God of tender love, who is good to all, whose "compassion is over all that he has made" (*Ps* 145:9). The history of salvation is worked out "in hope against hope" (*Rom* 4:18), through our weaknesses. All too often, we think that God works only through our better parts, yet most of his plans are realized in and despite our frailty. Thus Saint Paul could say: "To keep me from being too elated, a thorn was given me in the flesh, a messenger of Satan to torment me, to keep me from being too elated. Three times I appealed to the Lord about this, that it would leave me, but he said to me: 'My grace is sufficient for you, for power is made perfect in weakness'" (*2 Cor* 12:7-9). Since this is part of the entire economy of salvation, we must learn to look upon our weaknesses with tender mercy.



NAVIGATOR NEWS FROM THE SCHOOL

A Selection of Holy Week Reflections – Mrs. Sue Caroscio’s Junior High Religion classes marked Holy Thursday by reading the Bible passage (John 13:1-15) where Jesus washes the disciples feet. Each class then reflected on the ways Jesus has shown his love for them, and how they in turn show love to others. In 3rd grade, Mrs. Daisy Johnson’s students reflected on the significance of each day of Holy Week using Google slide presentations. They wrapped up their studies on Holy Thursday with a culminating webquest. In 1st grade, Mrs. Olivia Kostecke’s students discussed Holy Week and then designed crosses to match the quote, “Lord, through your cross you brought joy to the world.”

Easter Bunny S.T.E.M. in 1st Grade – In their Science class with Mrs. Olivia Kostecke, the 1st grade enjoyed a fun Eater-themed S.T.E.M. activity just before break. The students made catapults from craft sticks and rubber bands to see who could help the Easter Bunny (or a bunny-shaped Peeps) hop the farthest.

8th Grade Pedigree Studies – The 8th grade was recently studying pedigrees and inherited traits in Science class with Miss Jenna Baechle. As a summative project, the students created their own family pedigrees and chose one trait to track in their family history. They then identified the trait as dominant or recessive and which genotypes represented different phenotypes. The students presented their projects to the class and described how the trait was passed through the generations.

Preschool Letter Days Draw to a Close – Ms. Charlotte Thomas’ Preschool class enjoyed a variety of fun letter-themed activities as their Alphabet Days drew to a close.

For the letter S Day, the class spent some time in the gym learning to play soccer. The students worked on coordination skills and practiced trapping, dribbling and kicking. For the letter U Day, the students and their teachers all dressed in St. Brendan School uniforms. For the letter W Day, all activities centered on Water! The class began with a “sink or float” group activity, in which the class tried to predict if various items would sink or float in water. The theme continued through Art and table activities, which included blowing bingo dabber ink and water through a straw, using watercolor paint to trace the letter W, painting watercolor pictures, and creating an Ocean in a bottle! During their free exploration time, the students could fish for magnets with yarn fishing poles.

VACATION BIBLE SCHOOL NEWS

St. Brendan Parish will offer a revised in-person Vacation Bible School (VBS) this summer. Children who will be in Kindergarten - 6th grade during the 2021-2022 academic year (next school year) are eligible to participate. **VBS will take place June 21st-25th from 10-11:30am.** The fee is \$30 per child.

In order to follow the guidelines set forth by the Diocese of Cleveland, there is room for only **30 child participants** this year. All participants will be assisted throughout each VBS day by a small number of adult staff (5-10) and teen volunteers (10-15).

A reservation system using Sign-Up Genius will be used this year. The Sign-Up Genius link will be emailed to all School and PSR families on Sunday, April 18, at 2pm; contact the Religious Education Office if you would like to be added to this email list. After completing a reservation for each eligible child in your home, the Religious Education Office will contact you with the proper paper work and instructions for fee payment to complete and submit within two weeks. If your paperwork and fee are not submitted in this time frame, your child's reservation spot will open to someone on the Wait List.


