


Reading 1 2 Samuel 7:1-5, 8B-12, 14A, 16

When King David was settled in his palace, and the LORD had given him rest from his enemies on every side, he said to Nathan the prophet, "Here I am living in a house of cedar, while the ark of God dwells in a tent!"

Nathan answered the king, "Go, do whatever you have in mind, for the LORD is with you." But that night the LORD spoke to Nathan and said: "Go, tell my servant David, 'Thus says the LORD: Should you build me a house to dwell in?'" "It was I who took you from the pasture and from the care of the flock to be commander of my people Israel. I have been with you wherever you went, and I have destroyed all your enemies before you.

And I will make you famous like the great ones of the earth. I will fix a place for my people Israel; I will plant them so that they may dwell in their place without further disturbance. Neither shall the wicked continue to afflict them as they did of old, since the time I first appointed judges over my people Israel. I will give you rest from all your enemies. The LORD also reveals to you that he will establish a house for you. And when your time comes and you rest with your ancestors, I will raise up your heir after you, sprung from your loins, and I will make his kingdom firm. I will be a father to him, and he shall be a son to me. Your house and your kingdom shall endure forever before me; your throne shall stand firm forever."

David made many mistakes along the way, but you cannot deny that his heart was to please God. After a while of being attacked by his enemies, God gave David rest. While resting he came up with a plan to put the "Ark of God" in a more suitable place, but God had other plans. David's idea was a very good one. The only problem was God's plan did not include David when it came to building a temple for the ark. His plan included David's heir. If David would have decided to build this temple anyway, because it was a good idea, we can only imagine things would not have gone well. This should teach us that all things we want and do are not always what God wants of us. For me this story has taught me that I should pray on every decision I make. No matter how small or how big or how good the idea is, we should always ask God if it is what He wants of us. This week take time to review your life and the things you have in it. Are they things that has been approved by God? Has God asked you to be involved in those plans? God has specific plans for each of us, and we can all rest assured that those plans are perfect. Make a decision today to ask God for His direction in all your future plans. If it is orchestrated by Him we can be confident that all will go well.

Reading 2 Romans 16:25-27

Brothers and sisters: To him who can strengthen you, according to my gospel and the proclamation of Jesus Christ, according to the revelation of the mystery kept secret for long ages but now manifested through the prophetic writings and, according to the command of the eternal God, made known to all nations to bring about the obedience of faith, to the only wise God, through Jesus Christ be glory forever and ever. Amen.

Here Paul concludes his longest biblical letter. He reminds us that God can strengthen us through "His" Gospel and the preaching of Jesus Christ. Paul is saying that the gospel he has consistently preached in this letter to the Romans, is the final word on truth. In other words, NO ONE should accept any other version of the gospel of Jesus. That would be a false gospel (Galatians 1:8-9). Ask yourself, do you accept His Word as truth or do you bend it for your benefit? This week take time to ask God to reveal to you the things He desires of you to understand and know of His Word. Ask Him to use you for His glory today and always.

Gospel Luke 1:26-38

The angel Gabriel was sent from God to a town of Galilee called Nazareth, to a virgin betrothed to a man named Joseph, of the house of David, and the virgin's name was Mary. And coming to her, he said, "Hail, full of grace! The Lord is with you." But she was greatly troubled at what was said and pondered what sort of greeting this might be. Then the angel said to her, "Do not be afraid, Mary, for you have found favor with God.

"Behold, you will conceive in your womb and bear a son, and you shall name him Jesus. He will be great and will be called Son of the Most High, and the Lord God will give him the throne of David his father, and he will rule over the house of Jacob forever, and of his kingdom there will be no end." But Mary said to the angel, "How can this be, since I have no relations with a man?" And the angel said to her in reply, "The Holy Spirit will come upon you, and the power of the Most High will overshadow you. Therefore the child to be born will be called holy, the Son of God. And behold, Elizabeth, your relative, has also conceived a son in her old age, and this is the sixth month for her who was called barren; for nothing will be impossible for God." Mary said, "Behold, I am the handmaid of the Lord. May it be done to me according to your word." Then the angel departed from her.

Here we see God revealing that Mary was troubled. I would tend to think that Mary may have had some anxiety at Gabriel's presence. I think it is safe to say that putting ourselves in Mary's place, we would all feel many emotions, including being troubled. I can't even imagine what other emotions she was experiencing. Here Mary was merely going through her normal day living her ordinary life, not expecting anything special that day. Mary never questioned Gabriel. She simply opened her mind and heart to the word Gabriel was speaking to her. This tells me she had a great personal relationship with God. She had that intimate time with Him. Even though she was troubled, she was able to trust in everything Gabriel was telling her. Mary had different plans for her life than what God had planned for her, even though she was troubled she didn't argue with God and say, "no God, that's not what I planned for my life." So many times, we try to manipulate God's plans for us, and needless to say, our plans never exceed His. He has a perfect plan for all of us and some of it may trouble us. But we can rest assured that all will work out if we follow His lead for what He wants of us. Today I encourage you to seek God's plan for your life, and know that even though it may not be what you planned, it will far exceed any expectation you have for your life.
