Sunday, January 17, 2021

Reading I 1 Samuel 3:3b-10, 19

Samuel was sleeping in the temple of the LORD where the ark of God was. The LORD called to Samuel, who answered, "Here I am." Samuel ran to Eli and said, "Here I am. You called me." "I did not call you," Eli said. "Go back to sleep." So he went back to sleep. Again the LORD called Samuel, who rose and went to Eli. "Here I am," he said. "You called me." But Eli answered, "I did not call you, my son. Go back to sleep." At that time Samuel was not familiar with the LORD, because the LORD had not revealed anything to him as yet. The LORD called Samuel again, for the third time. Getting up and going to Eli, he said, "Here I am. You called me." Then Eli understood that the LORD was calling the youth. So he said to Samuel, "Go to sleep, and if you are called, reply, **Speak, LORD, for your servant is listening.**" When Samuel went to sleep in his place, the LORD came and revealed his presence, calling out as before, "Samuel, Samuel!" Samuel answered, "Speak, for your servant is listening." Samuel grew up, and the LORD was with him, not permitting any word of his to be without effect.

When God called for Samuel, he thought it was his master Eli. After the third time Eli realized God was speaking to Samuel in a voice that was familiar to him, so he would not be frightened. God wants us to listen to Him. I believe at times God speaks to us in voices that we recognize and trust. Sometimes it may sound like our own voice; sometimes it may sound like the voice of someone we know. But the point is that His voice will bring peace when God speaks. Many times when God speaks to us He does not boom from heaven. Although He can, most of the time He chooses to speak to us through what He calls "a still, small voice" that comes from our inner soul. In some situations, we may think we are talking to ourselves, but God's words, in our spirit, are always filled with a wisdom that we could never have on our own. As we read in last week's reading we know that God has a plan for each of us. Part of the plan He has for me is to write these devotionals. I can assure you that I am not worthy of this task, but God entrusted and equipped me to do just that. Many times after writing a devotional, I will read them and truly have no recollection of the things I wrote. One day in prayer God revealed to me in His "still, small voice" that it is not me writing them at all, but it is God using me for a time as this. You can be assured that God does not lead us to do foolish things. He speaks to us through His Word and never tells us to do anything that does not agree with His Word. He speaks to us through other people and even through our circumstances. Let me encourage you to begin to ask God to speak to you and then listen for His voice. He has so many good things to say to you!

Second Reading 1 Corinthians 6:13c-15a, 17-20

Brothers and sisters: The body is not for immorality, but for the Lord, and the Lord is for the body; God raised the Lord and will also raise us by his power. Do you not know that your bodies are members of Christ? But whoever is joined to the Lord becomes one Spirit with him. Avoid immorality. Every other sin a person commits is outside the body, but the immoral person sins against his own body. Do you not know that your body is a temple of the Holy Spirit within you, whom you have from God, and that you are not your own? For you have been purchased at a price. Therefore glorify God in your body.

If you are a Christian you have most likely heard this Scripture. "Your Body is His temple." Some people think that being a Christian only has to do with spiritual things and not physical things. However, Paul is very clear that your physical body, along with your spirit, were bought at a great price: the blood of Jesus (See 1 Corinthians 6:20). Your body is where the Holy Spirit lives. The question is, how do you treat your body? We must remember that good health and sexual purity are integral parts of glorifying God with your body. Take time today and pray for those who struggle with bad health habits as well as those who misuse their bodies. Pray that God will give them the courage to treat their bodies as He sees them. His temple!

Gospel John 1:35-42

John was standing with two of his disciples, and as he watched Jesus walk by, he said, "Behold, the Lamb of God." The two disciples heard what he said and followed Jesus. Jesus turned and saw them following him and said to them, "What are you looking for?" They said to him, "Rabbi" — which translated means Teacher —, "where are you staying?" He said to them, "Come, and you will see." So they went and saw where Jesus was staying, and they stayed with him that day. It was about four in the afternoon. Andrew, the brother of Simon Peter, was one of the two who heard John and followed Jesus. He first found his own brother Simon and told him, "We have found the Messiah" — which is translated Christ —. Then he brought him to Jesus. Jesus looked at him and said, "You are Simon the son of John; you will be called Cephas" — which is translated Peter.

"The Lamb of God". Have you ever wondered what that actually means? As we look back on the Old Testament, animal sacrifices are found all throughout this book. The Jewish belief was that the blood offerings acted as a temporary covering for sin (see Leviticus 4:35). The purpose of animal sacrifice and offerings were sanctification, righteousness and forgiveness. Hebrews 9:22 also sheds some light on the importance of blood offerings. Here we read that according to the Law of Moses, nearly everything was purified with blood. For without the shedding of blood there is no forgiveness. In summary, this was life under the law; the people knew if sin was present a sacrifice was necessary for redemption. These various sacrificial practices in Jewish culture often involved lambs; this animal had a very important place. Lambs are known for their white coats, and white is a symbol of purity and cleanliness. Now you can begin to see how and why Jesus is called the Lamb of God. He, too was stainless, perfect, and free of sin. He was perfectly pure. Romans 8:3 basically says that the Law of Moses was unable to save us because of the weakness of our sinful nature. So God did what the law could not do. He sent His own Son in the flesh. And like the lambs were sacrificed for sin, so was Christ. Take time this week to truly think about that! Jesus died for you and me! He died for everyone. The past, the present and the ones to come. Thank you Jesus for all you have done and all you are. Amen.
