Sunday, January 24

First Reading Jonah 3:1-5, 10

The word of the LORD came to Jonah, saying: “Set out for the great city of Nineveh, and announce to it the message that I will tell you.” So Jonah made ready and went to Nineveh, according to the LORD’S bidding. Now Nineveh was an enormously large city; it took three days to go through it. Jonah began his journey through the city, and had gone but a single day’s walk announcing, “Forty days more and Nineveh shall be destroyed,” when the people of Nineveh believed God; they proclaimed a fast and all of them, great and small, put on sackcloth. When God saw by their actions how they turned from their evil way, he repented of the evil that he had threatened to do to them; he did not carry it out.

Nineveh was the capitol of Israel’s ancient enemy. Jonah died inside the whale, but after three days God brought him back to life. God was not finished with Jonah. God came to him and asked him to go to the great city of Nineveh and announce a message. He was to proclaim to the citizens of Nineveh, that they were all doomed. His message was, “Forty days more and Nineveh shall be overthrown”. Upon receiving this message the people of Nineveh were moved and their hearts turned from evil. They put on sackcloth and ashes and begged God to forgive them. God seeing their hearts, does not carry out the punishment He had planned for them. Here we see the true heart of God. The people of Nineveh were obviously in such evilness that God had plans to destroy them all, yet when the reality of this hit them, their hearts repented and turned to Him. There are many times I have heard people say, “But you don’t know what I have done,” insinuating that God would never forgive them. This is a great picture of His forgiveness for all who turn to Him. If you feel that your past or where you are now is more than God can forgive, know that God’s heart is for you to worship and praise Him, and there is “Nothing” He can’t forgive you for! Nothing!!! I encourage you to give God all your heart and decide that from this minute forward, you will live for Him and your past is all but water under the bridge.

Second Reading 1 Corinthians 7:29-31

I tell you, brothers and sisters, the time is running out. From now on, let those having wives act as not having them, those weeping as not weeping, those rejoicing as not rejoicing, those buying as not owning, those using the world as not using it fully. For the world in its present form is passing away.

Here we see Paul proclaiming to the Corinthians that time is running out. Some read this and say, “You see, Paul told them that the end was near and that was some 2000 plus years ago”. The thing that most don’t understand is that time for us here on earth is very short. Many of us have heard our elders say, “Life is short. It goes so quickly”. I myself can attest to that. I see my grandchildren grow and go and it seems unreal to me how fast life is passing by. I believe Paul was telling them that we only have one life and it is gone in a blink of an eye. None of us know when our time will come. Whether we live to see Jesus’ return or not, when you die there are no second chances. There are no re-dos! So Paul is proclaiming to the Corinthians to pay attention while you are here. There are no promises of tomorrow, so live today for Him as though tomorrow may not come.

Gospel Mark 1:14-20

After John had been arrested,* Jesus came to Galilee proclaiming the gospel of God: “This is the time of fulfillment. The kingdom of God is at hand. Repent, and believe in the gospel.” The Call of the First Disciples. As he passed by the Sea of Galilee, he saw Simon and his brother Andrew casting their nets into the sea; they were fishermen. Jesus said to them, “Come after me, and I will make you fishers of men.” Then they abandoned their nets and followed him. He walked along a little farther and saw James, the son of Zebedee, and his brother John. They too were in a boat mending their nets. Then he called them. So they left their father Zebedee in the boat along with the hired men and followed him.

Many of Jesus’ disciples were fisherman. If you have ever been fishing you probably know that you may have to use many different types of bait to catch a fish. As a “fisher” of men and women, God ask us to demonstrate through our lives, words, and actions the blessings of following Him. Different people learn in many different ways. Some learn by seeing, some by doing, and some by listening. As for me, I learn by doing. I can watch, hear and read, but if I do, I will retain. I think it is one reason God has me doing these devotionals. By doing them, I retain so much more. Some people will respond to hearing about God, others will respond to your actions that demonstrate His love and grace, and still others by seeing the joy and peace you have in your life. Therefore everyday can and will bring opportunities to be a fisherman for God. I encourage you to ask God to bring to you the opportunities to draw others to His heart and His ways. Ask Him to use you to be His fishermen as He sees fit.


