





First Reading Genesis 9:8-15

God said to Noah and to his sons with him: “See, I am now establishing my covenant with you and your descendants after you and with every living creature that was with you: all the birds, and the various tame and wild animals that were with you and came out of the ark. I will establish my covenant with you, that never again shall all bodily creatures be destroyed by the waters of a flood; there shall not be another flood to devastate the earth.” God added: “This is the sign that I am giving for all ages to come, of the covenant between me and you and every living creature with you: I set my bow in the clouds to serve as a sign of the covenant between me and the earth. When I bring clouds over the earth, and the bow appears in the clouds, I will recall the covenant I have made between me and you and all living beings, so that the waters shall never again become a flood to destroy all mortal beings.”

I think it safe to say that we all have heard the story of Noah, the ark, and the flood. Some even view it in a children’s story with a big boat, animals and rainbows. This is a story of God’s love for his creatures as well as seeing the rainbow at the end of the storm, but there is also a side many skip over. The other side of the story is that God becomes so angered by human rebellion that He floods the entire earth, wiping out nearly everything that exist. Although God doesn’t wipe away the creation entirely and then walk away. The flood is in fact the start of a recreation. God washes the earth clean and both God and the earth begin again. How many of you would like to wipe away some of your past and begin again? That is exactly what God did for me and I can assure you He can do for you. God offers all of us a new beginning through Jesus and chances are you will not have to go through a flood to find it. He sent Jesus to give each and every one of us the opportunity to find a new beginning in this troubled world we live in. If you find yourself with the feeling of being in water over your head, I encourage you to simply reach up for Him. Allow Him to show you your rainbow at the end of that stormy day. It is available to all who love Him.

Second Reading 1 Peter 3:18-22

Beloved: Christ suffered for sins once, the righteous for the sake of the unrighteous, that he might lead you to God. Put to death in the flesh, he was brought to life in the Spirit. In it he also went to preach to the spirits in prison, who had once been disobedient while God patiently waited in the days of Noah during the building of the ark, in which a few persons, eight in all, were saved through water. This prefigured baptism, which saves you now. It is not a removal of dirt from the body but an appeal to God for a clear conscience, through the resurrection of Jesus Christ, who has gone into heaven and is at the right hand of God, with angels, authorities, and powers subject to him.

1 Peter 13: 18 is what our faith in Him is all about. It is the truth we all stand upon. Being a Christian can be summed up here in this passage. “Christ suffered for sins once, the righteous for the sake of the unrighteous, that he might lead you to God.” Here we read that Christ suffered for our sins, for not just you and me but for all who came before us and come after us. Jesus was righteous yet He suffered because we are unrighteous and need our sins atoned. Sin separates us from God. Many of us have suffered and will suffer in our lifetime. We must remember that Jesus did not promise us that we would not suffer. In fact He tells us that we will suffer, but we must remember that in our suffering and rejection by this world, if done in the name of Christ, we are alive to God and know that we have not been rejected by Him. This week take time to pray for the many who suffer and are rejected in the name of Christ. Pray that they will find comfort knowing they are loved by God.

Gospel Mark 1:12-15

The Spirit drove Jesus out into the desert, and he remained in the desert for forty days, tempted by Satan. He was among wild beasts, and the angels ministered to him. After John had been arrested, Jesus came to Galilee proclaiming the gospel of God: “This is the time of fulfillment. The kingdom of God is at hand. Repent, and believe in the gospel.”

We all struggle with temptation. But here we see that even Jesus was tempted. Here we read in today’s Gospel that Jesus was tempted by Satan for 40 days. Can you imagine being tempted by something for 40 days? It is hard for many of us to conquer one day of temptation much less 40 days. Add in the elements Jesus was dealing with and we all can just imagine the depth of what He endured and conquered. Mark 1:10 tells us that Jesus was filled with the Spirit. What is important to remember is that Jesus went into the wilderness equipped with armor of God. The good news is we have available to us the same power, the same Spirit. We too can be equipped to face any temptation as long as we keep God as our shield. I encourage you today if you are facing temptations know that you have the same power Jesus possessed and that is the Spirit of God. Also remember to stand in the gap for those who cannot stand for themselves. Stand strong with His armor and ask God to protect the many that fall to the worlds temptations. Ask God to reveal Himself to all those in most need.
