

Fourth Sunday of Lent

Reading I 2 Chronicles 36:14-16, 19-23

In those days, all the princes of Judah, the priests, and the people added infidelity to infidelity, practicing all the abominations of the nations and polluting the LORD's temple which he had consecrated in Jerusalem. Early and often did the LORD, the God of their fathers, send his messengers to them, for he had compassion on his people and his dwelling place. But they mocked the messengers of God, despised his warnings, and scoffed at his prophets, until the anger of the LORD against his people was so inflamed that there was no remedy. Their enemies burnt the house of God, tore down the walls of Jerusalem, set all its palaces afire, and destroyed all its precious objects. Those who escaped the sword were carried captive to Babylon, where they became servants of the king of the Chaldeans and his sons until the kingdom of the Persians came to power. All this was to fulfill the word of the LORD spoken by Jeremiah: "Until the land has retrieved its lost sabbaths, during all the time it lies waste it shall have rest while seventy years are fulfilled." In the first year of Cyrus, king of Persia, in order to fulfill the word of the LORD spoken by Jeremiah, the LORD inspired King Cyrus of Persia to issue this proclamation throughout his kingdom, both by word of mouth and in writing: "Thus says Cyrus, king of Persia: All the kingdoms of the earth the LORD, the God of heaven, has given to me, and he has also charged me to build him a house in Jerusalem, which is in Judah. Whoever, therefore, among you belongs to any part of his people, let him go up, and may his God be with him!"

As I write this devotional today, the world is in turmoil and disruptions over many political events and health issues. As I read this week's readings, I can't help but think that we are in a similar state that Ezra is speaking of here. God has used many to send His message to us, yet many of us are mocking the messengers. So many times we read in the Bible how God's people turned a blind eye and deaf ear to His ways and did what they wanted to with little to no regards to the heart of God's Word. There are times when I just couldn't understand why His people would do such a thing. Why would anyone turn a blind eye to God? Then in prayer God reminded me of the times I fell into the same fiery pit, before I knew Him. No matter what life you are living and where you find yourself now in these times, if you are praising God and thanking Him for the good in your life remember the times you were not worshiping him! For me it took prayers from someone else to pull me out of my sinful places. Some of which I most likely have no idea even took place. I encourage all who have a relationship with The Father, to take time today and pray. Pray for all who are lost. Pray for all who have turned a blind eye and deaf ear to God's Word. Take time to pray that His plan will be done in others' lives. Decide today to stand in the gap for those who don't even know they need help. May today be the day that God opens the eyes of the blind and the ears of the deaf. May His will be done here on earth as it is in heaven!

Second Reading Ephesians 2:4-10

Brothers and sisters: God, who is rich in mercy, because of the great love he had for us, even when we were dead in our transgressions, brought us to life with Christ — by grace you have been saved —, raised us up with him, and seated us with him in the heavens in Christ Jesus, that in the ages to come He might show the immeasurable riches of his grace in his kindness to us in Christ Jesus. For by grace you have been saved through faith, and this is not from you; it is the gift of God; it is not from works, so no one may boast. For we are his handiwork, created in Christ Jesus for the good works that God has prepared in advance, that we should live in them.

Even though we do not deserve it, God in His generosity offers us the grace of salvation. I can assure you that none of us deserve this gift. We read in Ephesians 2:6 that by grace we have been saved and that He raised us up with Him and He has seated us with Him in heaven. Isn't this beautiful? No matter what we have or haven't done in our walk toward eternity, our Lord offers us the grace to be with Him forever. God sees all of us, knows everything about us and wants us to be with Him forever in heaven. Even if the world rejects you, remember that the opinions of others are passing. But the one who is not passing is God and He longs for us to be in His company now and always. I want to invite you to begin your heaven on earth by spending time with Jesus in the Adoration Chapel.


Gospel John 3:14-21

Jesus said to Nicodemus: "Just as Moses lifted up the serpent in the desert, so must the Son of Man be lifted up, so that everyone who believes in him may have eternal life." For God so loved the world that he gave his only Son, so that everyone who believes in him might not perish but might have eternal life. For God did not send his Son into the world to condemn the world, but that the world might be saved through him. Whoever believes in him will not be condemned, but whoever does not believe has already been condemned, because he has not believed in the name of the only Son of God. And this is the verdict, that the light came into the world, but people preferred darkness to light, because their works were evil. For everyone who does wicked things hates the light and does not come toward the light, so that his works might not be exposed. But whoever lives the truth comes to the light, so that his works may be clearly seen as done in God.

"For God so loved the world that he gave his only Son, so that everyone who believes in him might not perish but might have eternal life." This is by far one of my favorite Scriptures. I would venture to say that most who have a relationship with God have heard this Scripture. God gave His son so we may live! Wow!! For many of you who have children, can you imagine giving your child to benefit others? Would you? I can't and frankly don't want to even think about that. And Jesus chose to participate freely for the sake of everyone! He died for all of our imperfections. We must remember that we are not perfect people. Neither is your family, friends and all you encounter in this world. But Jesus died for us anyway, knowing just how imperfect we are. Jesus' disciples were not perfect people either. But when they disappointed Him, He was not devastated because He already knew and fully understood human nature, as we learn in John 2:25. Jesus expected His disciples to do their best, but their best was still imperfect. Most of us like our lives to go just right. We also want people to cooperate with us. We want situations to go exactly the way we plan. But in reality this rarely happens. As Christians, we have the power of the Holy Spirit to help us deal with difficult times and difficult human imperfections. We are not put here for our lives to be easy and never have a need to use our faith. In reality, we will all have to face difficult situations in our lifetime, but it is your attitude in these trying times that will affect your enjoyment of life. Today choose to walk in truth and have a positive attitude as you deal with your own imperfections, as well as those around you. Ask God to use the Holy Spirit in you to react as Jesus did when His disciples disappointed Him. Ask God to help you be more like Jesus.
