



Reading I Isaiah 50:4-7

The Lord GOD has given me a well-trained tongue, that I might know how to speak to the weary a word that will rouse them. Morning after morning he opens my ear that I may hear; and I have not rebelled, have not turned back. I gave my back to those who beat me, my cheeks to those who plucked my beard; my face I did not shield from buffets and spitting. The Lord GOD is my help, therefore I am not disgraced; I have set my face like flint, knowing that I shall not be put to shame.

Isaiah said that the Lord had given him the tongue of a disciple so that he would know how to “speak a word in season” to the weary. If you look around I think all of us can see weary people in the body of Christ. The world has some serious problems that can truly wear us down, but as Christians we have something available to us that will allow us to experience joy no matter what is happening. Nehemiah 8:10 says, “The joy of the Lord is our strength.” God did not say the joy of the Lord is our strength just when things are going good. No, He said the joy of the Lord is our strength! Joy is not found in our circumstances; it is found in Christ, Who dwells in us. Decide today to find the only true joy there is, and that is joy found in Christ. Pray today that no matter what circumstance you find yourself in, that God will show you His true joy.

Reading II Philippians 2:6-11

Christ Jesus, though he was in the form of God, did not regard equality with God something to be grasped. Rather, he emptied himself, taking the form of a slave, coming in human likeness; and found human in appearance, he humbled himself, becoming obedient to the point of death, even death on a cross. Because of this, God greatly exalted him and bestowed on him the name which is above every name, that at the name of Jesus every knee should bend, of those in heaven and on earth and under the earth, and every tongue confess that Jesus Christ is Lord, to the glory of God the Father.

Here we see Jesus set an example of what it is to be obedient, even in your worst circumstance. Have you ever had others talk bad about you? Tell lies about you? Even spit in your face? Don't feel alone in your sorrow. Jesus felt the same things, and He was Jesus. He was sent here for the purpose of giving us the opportunity to spend eternity with God. But to do so He also shows us that obedience is a large part of our walk toward eternity. I encourage you to come up to a higher level of obedience. Pray that you will be quick and prompt to be obedient to the call of God and His ways. Pray for those that cannot stand for themselves. Pray that God will provide protections for those who cannot for themselves.

Gospel Mark 14:1—15:47 The Passover and the Feast of Unleavened Bread

Matthew, Mark and Luke all record that on the day Jesus was crucified, the sky turned eerily dark at the sixth hour of the day (noontime). The significance of this time is that at the exact moment Jesus was breathing His last breath on the Cross, Caiaphas the high priest was standing at his station in the inner court of the temple, preparing to offer blood of the spotless Passover lamb. At this very instant, Jesus exclaimed, “It is finished.” There were two veils inside the temple. One at the entrance to the Holy Place and a second entrance at the Holy of Holies. Only the high priest were allowed to pass through the second veil once a year. The second veil was sixty feet high, thirty feet wide, and an entire handbreadth (2 ½ to 4 inches) in thickness! I once read that it took 300 men to move or manipulate it. It would have been humanly impossible to tear this veil, and yet this veil ripped in half upon the death of Jesus. Imagine how shocked Caiaphas must have been when he heard the ripping of this veil as he watched it hit the floor. What was going through His mind when he saw the Holy of Holies was open and that God's Presence was no longer there? After Jesus' death it was no longer necessary for the high priest to continually make sacrifices year after year, for Jesus' blood had now settled the issue forever. Because of what Jesus did, we can now come boldly into the throne of grace, obtain mercy, and find grace to help in times of need (Hebrews 4:16). Take time this week and pray this prayer. “Lord, I thank You for destroying the veil that separated me from Your Presence. You have made it possible for me to access Your throne of grace, obtain mercy and receive help in my time of need in the Sacred Scriptures and in the Sacraments. Today I proclaim that I am washed by the blood of Jesus and I ask for the grace to remain in communion with the body, blood, soul and divinity of Jesus Christ in earth and forever in the Kingdom of Heaven. Amen!
