







Reading I: Acts 3:13-15, 17-19

Peter said to the people: “The God of Abraham, the God of Isaac, and the God of Jacob, the God of our fathers, has glorified his servant Jesus, whom you handed over and denied in Pilate’s presence when he had decided to release him. You denied the Holy and Righteous One and asked that a murderer be released to you. The author of life you put to death, but God raised him from the dead; of this we are witnesses. Now I know, brothers, that you acted out of ignorance, just as your leaders did; but God has thus brought to fulfillment what he had announced beforehand through the mouth of all the prophets, that his Christ would suffer. Repent, therefore, and be converted, that your sins may be wiped away.”

If you are struggling with sin or something you have done with regret in your life, I encourage you to repent. Sometimes that repentance may not just require you to repent to God but it may require you actually saying “I’m sorry” to the people you offended and/or hurt. Saying “I’m sorry” may not correct the situation at hand, but it is a great place to start. Even though we cannot force people to forgive us, we can entrust them to God who has the power to heal hearts and restore relationships. I want to invite you to ask God in prayer where He is calling you to repent. Once you discern your sins, bring them to Jesus in the Sacrament of Reconciliation. In addition to apologizing to our Lord, try and repair the damage that was done to His people who are made in His image and likeness. When we repent of our sins, reform our lives and make reparation for the hurt we have caused, we open ourselves up to authentic reconciliation not only with God, but also with our community.

Reading II: 1 John 2:1-5a

My children, I am writing this to you so that you may not commit sin. But if anyone does sin, we have an Advocate with the Father, Jesus Christ the righteous one. He is expiation for our sins, and not for our sins only but for those of the whole world. The way we may be sure that we know him is to keep his commandments. Those who say, “I know him,” but do not keep his commandments are liars, and the truth is not in them. But whoever keeps his word, the love of God is truly perfected in him.

Most Christians will tell you how much they love the Lord and how they want to please Him. Here John is telling us that to truly know and love the Lord we must know what He commands of us. We all have heard of the Ten Commandments, but can you recite them? Do you know what He commands of us so that we can live a holy life? I invite you to take time today to review the 10 commandments the Lord has given us to follow by reading Exodus 20. If you don’t already, make it a point to not only memorize His commandments, but make it your priority to work on living by them daily. John tells us that whoever keeps His word, the love of God is truly perfected in him. Ask God to help you follow His commands every day in your walk toward eternity.

Gospel: Luke 24:35-48

The two disciples recounted what had taken place on the way, and how Jesus was made known to them in the breaking of bread. While they were still speaking about this, he stood in their midst and said to them, “Peace be with you.” But they were startled and terrified and thought that they were seeing a ghost. Then he said to them, “Why are you troubled? And why do questions arise in your hearts? Look at my hands and my feet, that it is I myself. Touch me and see, because a ghost does not have flesh and bones as you can see I have.” And as he said this, he showed them his hands and his feet. While they were still incredulous for joy and were amazed, he asked them, “Have you anything here to eat?” They gave him a piece of baked fish; he took it and ate it in front of them. He said to them, “These are my words that I spoke to you while I was still with you, that everything written about me in the law of Moses and in the prophets and psalms must be fulfilled.” Then he opened their minds to understand the Scriptures. And he said to them, “Thus it is written that the Christ would suffer and rise from the dead on the third day and that repentance, for the forgiveness of sins, would be preached in his name to all the nations, beginning from Jerusalem. You are witnesses of these things.”

Fear is an acronym for false evidence appearing real.

I truly believe that fear played a large part in the hesitation of the Apostle’s belief in what they had been warned about by Jesus before His passion and death. In today’s Gospel, the disciples are in the presence of the resurrected Christ and they are afraid. Perhaps they were afraid because they thought Jesus left them. Maybe they feared that they might face the same type of execution. It’s possible their fear was rooted in not knowing what the future held for each of them. Whatever the reason for their fear, Jesus entered into relationship with them right where they were. He was able to calm their fears and help them to see the truth that was right there in front of them. The same truth is available to us here today, but we have to bring our fears to the light so Jesus can calm them in His will, way and time. Today if you find yourself overwhelmed by fear, ask Jesus to help you find peace in His truth. Ask Him to reveal to you the things He wants revealed and to put the lies of the enemy under your feet. It is His truth that will set you free.
