

FIRST READING – *A reading from the Acts of the Apostles (1:1-11)*

In the first book, Theophilus, I dealt with all that Jesus did and taught until the day he was taken up, after giving instructions through the Holy Spirit to the apostles whom he had chosen. He presented himself alive to them by many proofs after he had suffered, appearing to them during forty days and speaking about the kingdom of God. While meeting with them, he enjoined them not to depart from Jerusalem, but to wait for “the promise of the Father about which you have heard me speak; for John baptized with water, but in a few days you will be baptized with the Holy Spirit.” When they had gathered together they asked him, “Lord, are you at this time going to restore the kingdom to Israel?” He answered them, “It is not for you to know the times or seasons that the Father has established by his own authority. But you will receive power when the Holy Spirit comes upon you, and you will be my witnesses in Jerusalem, throughout Judea and Samaria, and to the ends of the earth.”

When he had said this, as they were looking on, he was lifted up, and a cloud took him from their sight. While they were looking intently at the sky as he was going, suddenly two men dressed in white garments stood beside them. They said, “Men of Galilee, why are you standing there looking at the sky? This Jesus who has been taken up from you into heaven will return in the same way as you have seen him going into heaven.”



Reading I: Acts 2:1-11

When the time for Pentecost was fulfilled, they were all in one place together. And suddenly there came from the sky a noise like a strong driving wind, and it filled the entire house in which they were. Then there appeared to them tongues as of fire, which parted and came to rest on each one of them. And they were all filled with the Holy Spirit and began to speak in different tongues, as the Spirit enabled them to proclaim. Now there were devout Jews from every nation under heaven staying in Jerusalem. At this sound, they gathered in a large crowd, but they were confused because each one heard them speaking in his own language. They were astounded, and in amazement they asked, "Are not all these people who are speaking Galileans? Then how does each of us hear them in his native language? We are Parthians, Medes, and Elamites, inhabitants of Mesopotamia, Judea and Cappadocia, Pontus and Asia, Phrygia and Pamphylia, Egypt and the districts of Libya near Cyrene, as well as travelers from Rome, both Jews and converts to Judaism, Cretans and Arabs, yet we hear them speaking in our own tongues of the mighty acts of God." Brothers and sisters: No one can say, "Jesus is Lord," except by the Holy Spirit. There are different kinds of spiritual gifts but the same Spirit; there are different forms of service but the same Lord; there are different workings but the same God who produces all of them in everyone. To each individual the manifestation of the Spirit is given for some benefit. As a body is one though it has many parts, and all the parts of the body, though many, are one body, so also Christ. For in one Spirit we were all baptized into one body, whether Jews or Greeks, slaves or free persons, and we were all given to drink of one Spirit.

Here we read Luke describe a noise like a wind. If you have lived in Louisiana for any time, you have most likely endured a hurricane or two. I can just imagine the sound of the Holy Spirit. I remember the first time I actually experienced that feeling of the Holy Spirit inside of me. It is the most awesome, peaceful, joyous and at times confusing thing one can experience. This same Spirit that the disciples experienced at Pentecost is available to each of us any time we are open to accepting Him into our lives. God is always available to each of us. He is around us always, but we have to open our hearts and minds to Him, if we want to experience this gift. As we spend this week celebrating Pentecost, I encourage you to invite the Holy Spirit into your life. Ask God to consume your being and your every moment. Invite Him to dwell inside of you today and always.

Reading II: Gal 5:16-25

Brothers and sisters, live by the Spirit and you will certainly not gratify the desire of the flesh. For the flesh has desires against the Spirit, and the Spirit against the flesh; these are opposed to each other, so that you may not do what you want. But if you are guided by the Spirit, you are not under the law. Now the works of the flesh are obvious: immorality, impurity, lust, idolatry, sorcery, hatreds, rivalry, jealousy, outbursts of fury, acts of selfishness, dissensions, factions, occasions of envy, drinking bouts, orgies, and the like. I warn you, as I warned you before, that those who do such things will not inherit the kingdom of God. In contrast, the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, generosity, faithfulness, gentleness, self-control. Against such there is no law. Now those who belong to Christ Jesus have crucified their flesh with its passions and desires. If we live in the Spirit, let us also follow the Spirit.

Paul said we should choose to walk and live in the Spirit. By choosing to do this, we rebuke the lusts of the flesh and the temptations we face daily. There are many things tugging at us throughout our day. We find ourselves struggling with suggestions from the devil, through our family, peers, co-workers, classmates and neighbors. We also experience the temptations of the enemy in our minds and our bodies.

Once we are aware of the temptation, we have the free choice to accept the suggestions and delight in them or reject them and reorient our attention to the face of God.

Galatians 5:16 says, "The Holy Spirit is the One Who knows the will of God and Who is sent to dwell in each of us to aid us in being all God has designed us to be and to have all God wants us to have." When we allow the Holy Spirit to lead us, He becomes involved in every decision we make. He will lead us by peace and wisdom through the Church's teachings found in Sacred Tradition and Sacred Scriptures. I encourage you today to seek the Holy Spirit for all decisions in your life. There are times we may not always understand where He is leading us, but it is His promise that if you trust and obey we will find the peace and contentment in our daily living.

Gospel: John 15:26-27; 16:12-15

Jesus said to his disciples: "When the Advocate comes whom I will send you from the Father, the Spirit of truth that proceeds from the Father, he will testify to me. And you also testify, because you have been with me from the beginning. "I have much more to tell you, but you cannot bear it now. But when he comes, the Spirit of truth, he will guide you to all truth. He will not speak on his own, but he will speak what he hears, and will declare to you the things that are coming. He will glorify me, because he will take from what is mine and declare it to you. Everything that the Father has is mine; for this reason I told you that he will take from what is mine and declare it to you."

Truth is one of the most powerful weapons a believer has against the kingdom of darkness. Truth is light, and the Bible says that darkness has never overpowered the light, and it never will (see John 1:5). Jesus also said in John 8:32, "The Truth will set you free". Being truthful with a non-believer will not always be received with favorable emotions. Evil, (darkness) does not like the truth (light), but light will always overcome darkness. I have a night-light in my extra bedroom for when my grandchildren spend the night. This night-light has an extremely small bulb in it, but when it is turned on in the darkness it will light up the entire room. It is impossible for darkness to overcome light, even the smallest of lights. Jesus could have showed His disciples all the truth (the light), but John 16:12-13 reveals that He knew they were not ready for it. He told them that they needed to wait until the Holy Spirit came down from heaven to abide with them and to dwell in them. We know that after Jesus ascended into heaven, He did indeed send the Holy Spirit (see Acts 2:1-18). God had a plan for the disciples and He has a plan for you as well. He will equip you with what you need at the exact time you need it if you seek His will. This week I encourage you to seek His will. Ask God to send the Holy Spirit upon our life so that you may walk in His Truth and share that same Truth with those around you.
