The Solemnity of the Most Holy Trinity

May 30, 2021

Reading I: Deuteronomy 4:32-34, 39-40

Moses said to the people: "Ask now of the days of old, before your time, ever since God created man upon the earth; ask from one end of the sky to the other: Did anything so great ever happen before? Was it ever heard of? Did a people ever hear the voice of God speaking from the midst of fire, as you did, and live? Or did any god venture to go and take a nation for himself from the midst of another nation, by testings, by signs and wonders, by war, with strong hand and outstretched arm, and by great terrors, all of which the LORD, your God, did for you in Egypt before your very eyes? This is why you must now know, and fix in your heart, that the LORD is God in the heavens above and on earth below, and that there is no other. You must keep his statutes and commandments that I enjoin on you today, that you and your children after you may prosper, and that you may have long life on the land which the LORD, your God, is giving you forever."

Deuteronomy is a book about our never-ending need for God and His presence in our life here on earth. Here Moses is telling us that we are to fix our hearts on God. He goes further and explains that there are no other gods before Him and we are to keep His commandments. By keeping His commandments we will not only find blessings ourselves but we will intern bless the generations that follow so that they may prosper as well. If you are a parent, I encourage you to do your part and teach your children the laws of God. Take time to remind them of the importance in His Word. If you are not a parent, I encourage you to take time to share His Word with others you may encounter in your walk here on earth. It is another step in assuring a life of eternity with Him.

Reading II: Romans 8:14-17

Brothers and sisters:

For those who are led by the Spirit of God are sons of God. For you did not receive a spirit of slavery to fall back into fear, but you received a Spirit of adoption, through whom we cry, "Abba, Father!" The Spirit himself bears witness with our spirit that we are children of God, and if children, then heirs, heirs of God and joint heirs with Christ, if only we suffer with him so that we may also be glorified with him.

We are all created to be children of God, therefore God is telling us we have gained the privilege to become His heir. The definition of heir is a person legally entitled to the property or rank of another on that person's death. Wow! Here we read that on the death of Jesus, God has given us the opportunity to inherit eternity with Him. We were previously outsiders. We were sinners, but His great mercy redeemed us and purchased us with the blood of His own Son. God thought love is worth dying for. God thought you were worth dying for! If you find yourself alone and feeling unloved, remember that you are adopted, accepted, and loved by a God that will never leave you nor forsake you. Amen.

Gospel: Matthew 28:16-20

The eleven disciples went to Galilee, to the mountain to which Jesus had ordered them. When they all saw him, they worshiped, but they doubted. Then Jesus approached and said to them, "All power in heaven and on earth has been given to me. Go, therefore, and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit, teaching them to observe all that I have commanded you. And behold, I am with you always, until the end of the age."

Have you ever wondered about your purpose in life? Many people live their entire life wondering just that, and somehow missing it when God speaks to them. Here Jesus is explaining to His disciples what they were put here on earth to do. He had been preparing them for this purpose for the past three years. They could have left this conversation with Jesus and said, "I still don't know what you want of us." I am sure that many of them left with much uncertainty on what they were being asked to do. But they left in faith that He would guide them along the way. I believe there are times God speaks to us about our destination and His desires

for us. Yet we find ourselves either questioning if what we are being lead to do is really God. We also have times that we simply walk away from it because our flesh desires something else. What I am sure of, is that God has a purpose for each and every one of us. He has a specific path that He desires for us to take and He will reveal it to each of us when the time is right. He had a specific purpose for these men. He had a specific purpose for our Mother Mary, and He has a specific purpose for you. If you are still searching for your purpose in life, I invite you to seek God. Take time to spend in His presence. Ask God to reveal to you what His desires are for your life, and when it is revealed to you remember to take those steps toward your purpose with faith that He will be with you always. If He is giving you this purpose, He will also be with you through it. Amen.
