**First Sunday in Lent****FROM THE  
PASTOR'S DESK**

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

During Lent, we enter into the spiritual desert with Jesus. The whole Church essentially goes on retreat in this time. We focus on our relationship with God through prayer, fasting, and almsgiving. In prayer, we embrace God's grace and then pass it along through acts of charity or almsgiving. By fasting, we seek fulfillment in God himself by turning away from the lesser pleasures of the world. Going to confession is the ultimate form of repentance (take a look at additional confession times in this bulletin). Those who diligently observe Lent are spiritually renewed by Easter, the feast of our salvation.

Lent is intentionally sober. The vestments are purple, which symbolizes penance, preparation, and sacrifice. In the Liturgy, we do not proclaim the joyful Alleluia or Gloria (except for solemnities such as St. Joseph, March 19<sup>th</sup>). Musical instruments are played only to support the singing and the altar is not decorated with flowers (except for solemnities and the Fourth Sunday of Lent also known as Laetare or the Sunday of rejoicing when rose vestments are worn.) Passiontide extends from the Fifth Sunday of Lent to Holy Saturday. In this most penitential period, statues are traditionally covered as a sensory fast as we concentrate on the Crucifixion in anticipation of the Resurrection.

Like most things, the grace of Lent is use it or lose it. By now we should have a plan for prayer, fasting, and almsgiving. My prayer is \_\_\_\_\_. My fasting is \_\_\_\_\_. My almsgiving is \_\_\_\_\_. Putting this plan into practice is the harder part. May God bless you!

A new beginning! That is what our readings for this Sunday reflect. While Lent is generally associated more with penance, the idea of beginning anew is more positive. The Lenten liturgy classifies Lent as a "joyful season," as the time when our community celebrates the paschal mystery "with mind and heart renewed." In the mind of the Church, Lent is a positive time, a time for new life to appear and old attitudes to disappear, a time to celebrate the mystery of Christ's death and resurrection.

Even in the darkness of sin, the waters of the flood that covered the earth, God shines forth with a covenant that will be established forever with all creation. The flood is seen as a symbol of our baptism and baptism restores us to a loving friendship with God. Even though Jesus was tempted in the desert for forty days, the origin of our Lenten season, He emerged unscathed proclaiming, "the kingdom of God is at hand"

Jesus is the kingdom of God. Follow Him in these forty days of Lent." "Repent and believe in the gospel," believe in the "good news" which is Christ himself. He can make all our troubles disappear, just like the flood waters receded and new life burst through. By living the example of Jesus during these forty days of Lent, we will emerge renewed, full of hope and full of joy. May your Lenten journey bring you to the joys of Easter.

**It's Pirohy Time!!!**

We plan on having our second sale of 2021 February 28 2021. Our first sale this year, February 12th was a huge success. We sold out of everything we made!! We desperately need HELP to make this successful. If we don't get enough volunteers we will have to cancel. Sign-up sheets are in the back of the church. You may also call the office to sign up. Even if you can only *spare one or two hours* it will be much appreciated! We make them at St. Cyril's Hall.

**Wednesday, February 24 6:00 am-9:00 am**

We cook the cabbage and sauerkraut in large stockpots, which must be lifted while full of hot water and food. Later the pots need cleaned.

**Thursday, February 25 7:00 am-9:00 am**

We cook the potatoes and mash them in a large commercial mixer. We roll the balls in preparation for filling on Fridays. We prepare and package the haluski. We set up tables for the sale on Fridays.

**Friday, February 26 7:30 am-noon**

We mix the dough in a commercial mixer, roll it out and cut the dough into circles. We form the pirohy by wrapping/pinching dough around the balls. We then cook the pirohy in stockpots. Once pirohy is cooled it is prepared for packaging and counted into one or two dozen containers.



Orders are filled from 11am-1:30pm or 1:30 pm-4 pm

Pirohy cost \$6 a dozen and the choices are either potato and cheese or sweet cabbage. Halusky is \$3.50, Halusky with cabbage is \$3.75. Order by calling the kitchen on Monday or Tuesday at 330-393-0781 to place orders. PICK UP is on Friday, Noon-4pm. (NO EARLY PICKUPS)
