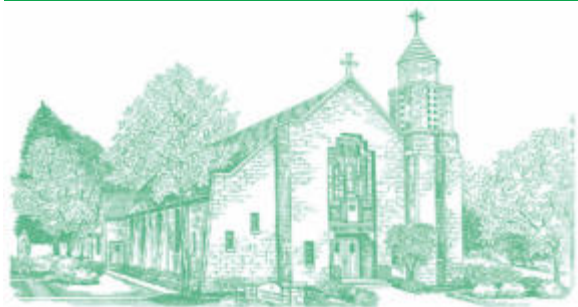

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

We owe a great debt of gratitude to the volunteers who are working very hard on the pirohy, kolachi, and Easter bread sales in these weeks before Easter. In addition to increasing our parish revenue, such fundraisers strengthen community bonds and expand our outreach to the community as we interface with non-parishioner customers. Thank you for helping!

Passiontide begins with the Fifth Sunday of Lent next week. In this period, the Church meditates even more deliberately on the suffering and death of Jesus. To highlight the penitential dynamic, crosses and sacred images are traditionally covered throughout Passiontide until the end of the celebration of the Lord's Passion on Good Friday. We will exercise this option at St. Elizabeth Ann Seton this year. I think of it as an additional layer of fasting. Fasting from the beautiful images of Our Lord and Our Lady increases our desire to see them again in the celebration of the Paschal Mystery. The Holy Week Mass times are listed in this bulletin. Please note the opportunities for confession before Easter. May God bless you!

Easter Sunday Mass Social Distancing

To facilitate social distancing on Easter Sunday, an overflow space of distanced seating will be set up in church social halls during the 8:30 AM (Sts. C&M) and 11:00 AM (St. James) Masses. We will show the livestream feed of the Mass from St. Elizabeth Ann Seton on the projector screen and Holy Communion will be distributed in the hall. Congregants will be directed to the halls once seating capacity in the churches is reached: 225 at St. James and 90 at Sts. C&M. Seating in the churches and halls will be available on a first come, first served basis. The parish council and I believe that this is our best option for Covid safety. To be clear, we will NOT be issuing tickets for Easter Masses. Come early!

Fourth Sunday of Lent

Here we are four weeks into Lent. How is our journey going? In the first Sunday of Lent I shared with you how the Lenten Liturgy classifies Lent as a "joyful season," as the time when our community celebrates the paschal mystery "with mind and heart renewed." Well today is Laetare ("Rejoice") Sunday, we anticipate the joy we feel at Easter. That is why we wear the rose colored vestments, it is a joyful color. Just like the Gospel is "Good News," we can feel good because the only Son of God was given up to die for us, so we could be saved through Him. God does not seek the destruction of humanity, but loves all the world and wants all of the world to come to believe in Him and share eternal life with Him.

This is the task before us, do we believe this or not? If we don't we "have already been condemned." But if we do believe, we will share eternal life with all who have gone before us marked with the sign of faith.

Believe in the Gospel, the "Good News" which is Christ. Jesus showed us the way to everlasting life. By being a servant to all, by laying down one's life for another. In the words of Bishop Robert Barron, "Love is willing the good of the other as other." This is Jesus' message for us, "Love one another as I have loved you." And if we do, we too can "Rejoice" with all who have gone before us.

Greetings Fellow Parishioners!

I hope your Lenten promises are being kept up! During the season of Lent, the Church ascribes to her faithful ones certain actions that help to redirect themselves back to Christ. These actions include prayer, almsgiving and fasting. I hope you have considered implementing these stated actions during Lent.

I would like to offer to all the families of our parish, a plan to renew in our homes a time for more community and habitual prayer; by **establishing during the week a day, possibly two or more as you progress through Lent, and pick a time in the evening to pray together. During this time, either: read the Readings of the day and end with an Our Father; or pray a devotional prayer (like the Rosary, Stations of the Cross, Divine Mercy Chaplet, etc.). Also during that time we will be writing Easter cards and wrap small gifts for our elderly parishioners in Nursing homes and those who are home bound. Please consider being a part of this time of fellowship, charity and prayer!
