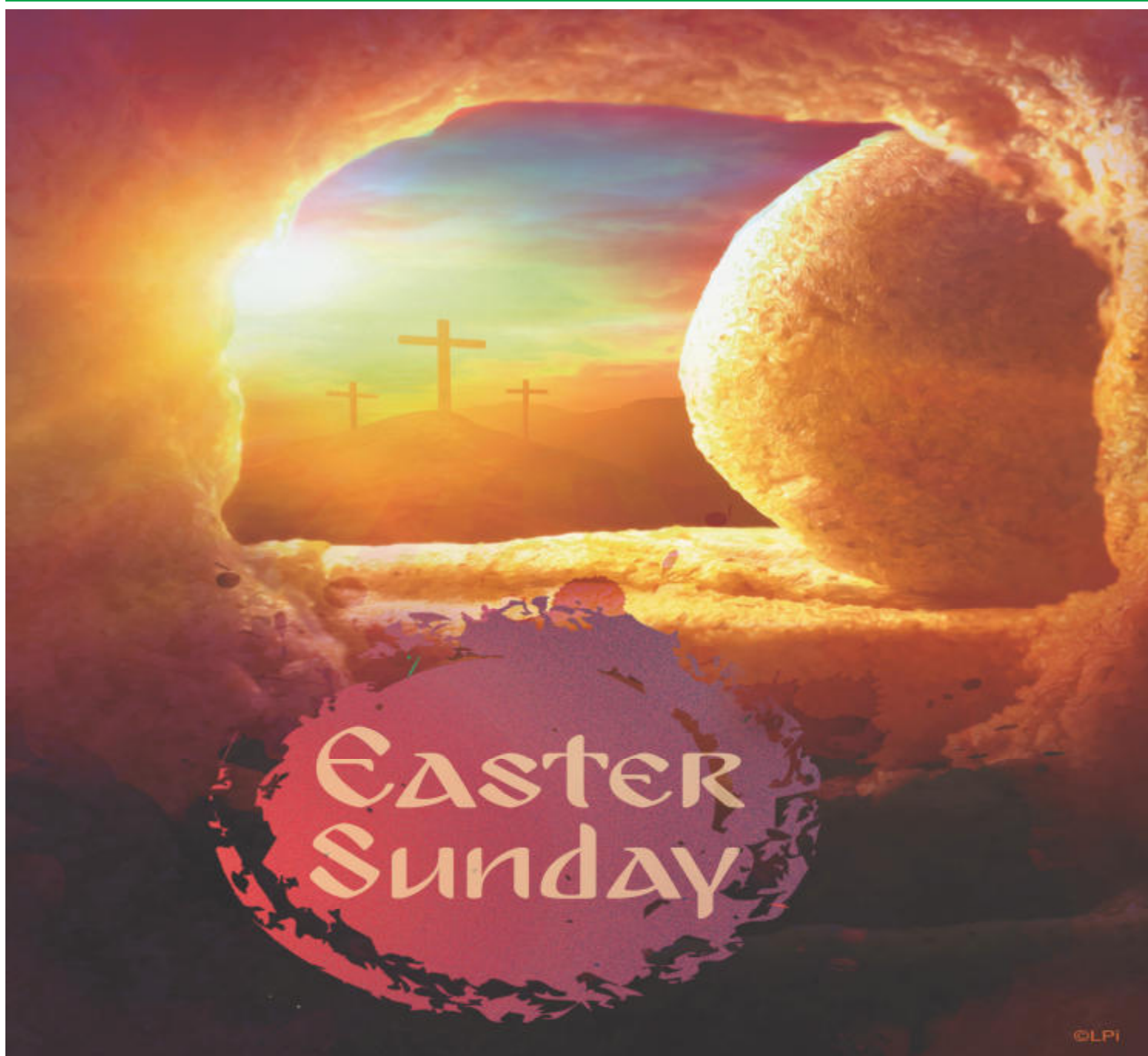

FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

Christ is risen, alleluia! Thank you for celebrating Easter Sunday with us today. Although Christmas has a higher profile in our culture, Easter is the most solemn feast on the Christian calendar. The Resurrection proves that sin and death had no power over Christ. On the Cross, Jesus made a total gift of himself to the Father. Though innocent and undeserving of punishment, He lowered himself to the point of death under the weight of the sins of the whole world. He descended into Hell to rescue the souls of the just. On Easter Sunday, He rose from the dead. Forty days later, he ascended to Heaven in the flesh. Through this Paschal Mystery, Jesus initiated the path of salvation and eternal life for us all. As Christians, we enter into Christ's death and resurrection through Baptism. The water of Baptism signifies both death (think of the destruction of a flood) and life (think of a refreshing bath or the quenching of thirst). For this reason, on Easter, we renew our Baptismal promises and are sprinkled by the water that has destined us for life eternal. In short, this is the feast of our salvation.

I am very grateful to the parish staff and volunteers who made Holy Week so special. Fr. Trimbur, Deacons Bob, Ed, and Joe, the liturgical ministers, musicians, decorators, and many others have been so generous, thank you! Celebrate Easter joyfully and safely today. Enjoy the candy and ethnic traditions. Roast a leg of lamb. Our Lenten fast is over, but not forgotten. The humility of the Cross led to the glory of the Resurrection. I pray that the lowliness of our Lenten journey has brought us new life in the Spirit. May God bless you! Happy Easter!

Easter Sunday Mass Social Distancing

To facilitate social distancing on Easter Sunday, an overflow space of distanced seating will be set up in church social halls during the 8:30 AM (Sts. C&M) and 11:00 AM (St. James) Masses. We will show the livestream feed of the Mass from St. Elizabeth Ann Seton on the projector screen and Holy Communion will be distributed in the hall. Congregants will be directed to the halls once seating capacity in the churches is reached: 225 at St. James and 90 at Sts. C&M. Seating in the churches and halls will be available on a first come, first served basis. The parish council and I believe that this is our best option for Covid safety. To be clear, we will NOT be issuing tickets for Easter Masses. Come early!

The Wedding Anniversary Celebration will include Mass with Bishop David J. Bonnar, renewal of marriage vows and a personalized certificate for each couple. Couples may opt to attend the Wedding Anniversary Celebration Mass in person at St. Columba Cathedral or they may participate remotely via livestreaming on the diocesan website at www.doy.org. Limited spaces are available for couples at the cathedral. You must make reservations in advance for this event by contacting the parish office before **May 13**.

It's Pirohy Time!!!

We plan on having our **Final Pirohy Sale** on **Friday, April 16, 2021**. Sign-up sheets are in the back of the church for those able to help. You may also call the office to sign up. Even if you can only *spare one or two hours* it will be much appreciated! We make them at St. Cyril's Hall.

Wednesday, April 14 6:00 am-10:00 am

We cook the cabbage and sauerkraut in large stockpots, which must be lifted while full of hot water and food. Later the pots need cleaned.

Thursday, April 15 7:00 am-10:00 am

We cook the potatoes and mash them in a large commercial mixer. We roll the balls in preparation for filling on Fridays. We prepare and package the haluski. We set up tables for the sale on Fridays.

Friday, April 16 7:30 am-noon

We mix the dough in a commercial mixer, roll it out and cut the dough into circles. We form the pirohy by wrapping/pinching dough around the balls. We then cook the pirohy in stockpots. Once pirohy is cooled it is prepared for packaging and counted into one or two dozen containers.



Pirohy cost \$6 a dozen and the choices are :

Potato & Cheese

Cabbage

Kraut

Prune (Lek
var)

Plain Haluski is \$3.50,

Haluski with cabbage is \$3.75.

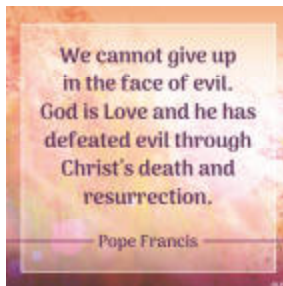
