Twenty-Ninth Sunday in Ordinary Time

Thought for the week of October 17: Are we comfortable in following Jesus in his role as Servant of all?

On the long journey to Jerusalem Jesus has been attempting to convey to his disciples some sense of the fate that awaits him in Jerusalem. Three times he has made clear that his destiny is to suffer and die. The disciples, who now understand that He is the Messiah, cannot hold together these two truths: that he is Messiah and that he is going to discharge his messianic role through this way of suffering and death. They cling to the idea that the Messiah will be a righteous, triumphant ruler who will restore to Israel the glories of the kingdom of David.

This understanding of messiahship lies behind the request of the sons of Zebedee, James and John in today's Gospel. Their bid for places on His right and left signals their personal ambition for glory and ask Jesus for top places of honor in his kingdom. They have not grasped anything of what Jesus has been saying: that the path to any glory leads through suffering and death.

The remaining disciples are irritated at what they see as an attempt of James and John to get the highest places in Jesus' kingdom. Jesus takes this opportunity to explain the difference between leadership in this world, where those in authority use their power to turn everything to their own advantage. On the contrary, those who aspire to leadership in the community of the Kingdom must think of themselves as slaves of all.

One of the most important statements in this gospel, where Jesus uses himself as an example, "the Son of Man has come, not to be served, but to serve and give his life as a ransom for many."

This week's readings present a challenge in the matter of the exercise of power and authority. Both have been difficult areas for the church to get right down through the ages. We worship Jesus as Lord. But are we so comfortable in venerating- and following – him in his role as Servant of all?

World Mission Sunday

On October 23-24 this year will be the annual, worldwide Eucharistic celebration of World Mission Sunday for Missions and missionaries of the world. "We cannot but speak about what we have seen and heard" (Acts 4:20), Pope Francis teaches us about our shared baptismal call to mission. We encourage our parishioners to answer that call on that special Sunday through prayer and generous sacrifice to the Missions.

World Mission Sunday provides us with your gifts to the **Pontifical Missions Societies**, who support and sustain priests, religious and lay pastoral leaders in more than 1,100 mission dioceses in Asia, Africa, the Pacific Islands, and parts of Latin America and Europe as they proclaim the Gospel, build the Church, serve the poor—and speak of our shared faith in all corners of the world.

World Mission Sunday provides us with the opportunity to support the **Black and Indian Missions Office of the United States Conference of Catholic Bishops**. These funds assist our Diocese of Youngstown as well as others across the nation to support evangelization to Black and Native American Missions.

It's Pirohy Time!!!

Sign-up sheets are in the back of the church for anyone able to help with the pirohy. You may also call the office to sign up. Even if you can only *spare one or two hours* it will be much appreciated! We make them at St. Cyril's Hall.



Wednesday, October 20 6:00 am-10:00 am

We cook the cabbage and sauerkraut in large stockpots, which must be lifted while full of hot water and food. Later the pots need cleaned.

Thursday, October 21 7:00 am-10:00 am

We cook the potatoes and mash them in a large commercial mixer. We roll the balls in preparation for filling on Fridays. We prepare and package the haluski. We set up tables for the sale on Fridays.

Friday, October 22 7:30 am-noon

We mix the dough in a commercial mixer, roll it out and cut the dough into circles. We form the pirohy by wrapping/pinching dough around the balls. We then cook the pirohy in stockpots. Once pirohy is cooled it is prepared for packaging and counted into one or two dozen containers. **Orders are then picked up by customers from 12:00 -4 pm on Friday October 22.**

Pirohy cost \$7 per dozen. We have potato and cheese pirohy or sweet cabbage pirohy.

Haluski cost \$4 a bag. We have with or without cabbage.
