

I would like to take this opportunity to thank each of you for your generosity in preparing a home for our Sisters, as well as your many kindnesses during their mission in your midst!

As you may know, we have a small number of Sisters able to be missioned and quite a number of priests and Bishops who have requested Parish Visitors of Mary Immaculate in their dioceses/parishes. It is because of our small numbers that I could send Sister Mary Beata and Sister Debra Marie for only a temporary mission.

How I would love for the "temporary" to be permanent! I am aware of the needs of the Parishes for which Father Cicero is responsible. Unfortunately, at the present time it is not possible to send Sisters on a permanent basis.

However, for the time being, it may be possible to continue temporary missions: 3 or 4 months at a time, if that would be agreeable to Father Cicero.

We will be having our General Chapter in June, 2022, at which time I will be better able to determine availability of Sisters, long-term. Would you be willing and able to wait that long, given the real needs of your parish Community?
