Pastor's Notes**

On this Sunday we are still at Christmas. Do not turn off the lights of the tree, do not end with the time of Christmas that is still alive and the joy of having Jesus next to Mary and Joseph, lead us to contemplate the ineffable, great and wonderful gift of being part of a family.

In the gift of the family are the treasures of life. Like the vocation of parents to educate their children with the living example of love, respect and fidelity. With authentic values that help them to develop, to grow as true and authentic members of society, learning faith at home, children will be the living witness of an authentic faith, alive and full of works of service for the benefit of all, but especially of those most in need.

Through the family we find in the home the school of values, respect, mutual help, sharing, serving, forgiving and ultimately it is the school of love. There at home we learn to love the people God has given us and that love must grow in the sincere effort to make God present in the midst of each family member's life.

We know that today there are challenges and struggles against many things, although necessary in society that must be constantly revalued, to prevent them from becoming a priority, or slavery and a distortion of values, the sacred and the essential for family life.

Today we have the great challenge to form a family, to educate parents about their responsibility to teach their children by the example of their lives in the true faith. We always remind parents that they are the living image of God for their children, and the image they transmit with their lives will allow their children to know the true God.

How many people find it hard to believe in God as a "Good Father" if the father or mother they have does not behave as such, or is absent from the lives of their children, does not give them love, company, does not share the different moments of their existence. Many parents strive, sacrifice to give their children the best, but sometimes what they give them is only material.

To many people God is in the day-to-day. They do not need to question his existence because from the time they are little, mom reflects God as being alive even on cold days, on vacations, in the responsibility of going every Sunday to Mass, in preparing for the sacraments, in giving us teaspoons of faith in each illness, in every crisis and in every important moment of life.

The family today must turn its gaze to the manger and contemplate in the midst of nowhere the Savior of the world with his parents. Growing up we see them being part of a community, but at the same time seeking to hear and talk about the things of God. What a great mystery for 12-year-old to talk about God the Father. How much we would like the children of that age to follow the example of Christ!

The liturgical season of Christmas began with the Vigil Masses on Christmas Eve and concludes with the feast of the Baptism of the Lord.

The Octave of Christmas is the celebration, within the Christmas period, of the eight days following the Christmas Mass. After the Nativity of the Lord, the Octave is ordained as follows:

On December 26, St. Stephen, the protomartyr, is remembered, who gave his life to proclaim Christ.

On December 27, the beloved disciple is commemorated, St. John, who announced from his experience of faith that God is Love.

The Holy Innocents, *on December 28*, celebrates the memory of the children who were killed by Herod's blind fury because of Jesus.

On the second Sunday of Christmas, the Church celebrates the Holy Family. "The memory of Joseph, Mary and the baby Jesus, who go to Jerusalem, to perform the rites of the Passover.

Finally, *on January 1*, Mary Mother of God is celebrated. And with this Solemnity ends the octave of Christmas.

La Octava de Navidad es la celebración, dentro del período navideño, de los ocho días siguientes a la Misa de Navidad. Después de la Natividad del Señor, la Octava se ordena de la siguiente manera:

El 26 de diciembre se recuerda a San Esteban, el protomártir, que dio su vida para anunciar a Cristo.

El 27 de diciembre se conmemora al discípulo amado, San Juan, quien anunció desde su experiencia de fe que Dios es Amor. Los Santos Inocentes, *el 28 de diciembre*, celebra la memoria de los niños que fueron asesinados por la furia ciega de Herodes a causa de Jesús.

El segundo domingo de Navidad, la Iglesia celebra a la Sagrada Familia. "El recuerdo de José, María y el bebé Jesús, que va a Jerusalén, para realizar los ritos de la Pascua.
