

Muy queridos feligreses, con el ánimo de comenzar un nuevo año, con la intención de progresar en la revelación que las lecturas dominicales hacen a nuestra comunidad: la semana pasada nos revelaban al Padre Eterno queriendo desposarse con su pueblo Israel, Al Espíritu Santo animando todos los carismas en cada persona y al Hijo de Dios, revelar su Gloria en las bodas de Caná.

Hoy se nos revela, consecuentemente, el gozo que debe acompañar el escuchar la Palabra de Dios, el don de ser parte viva del “Cuerpo de Cristo” y de recibir por la gracia del Espíritu Santo a Cristo Palabra que obra en los corazones, en la vida de las comunidades como la Buena Nueva de la salvación, trayendo enseñanza, sabiduría, sanación, interpretación, consuelo y fortaleza a todo el Cuerpo de Cristo.

Hoy, podríamos decir, Dios nos llama a vivir nuestra fe de manera auténtica, decidida, comprometida, en la unidad de la Iglesia, en el compromiso de ser parte activa en comunión con los pastores de la Iglesia, en la vivencia del Espíritu que nos anima a todos a funcionar en el amor y en la caridad, en la verdad y en la justicia, en la humildad y en la santidad, en la alegría y en el gozo de una oración que se hace vida, en obras que fortalecen la misericordia, la caridad y la solidaridad.

Podríamos pensar en cuáles son los frutos de nuestras oraciones, de nuestras celebraciones dominicales, de la recepción de los sacramentos, de los tiempos que le dedicamos al estudio bíblico, a recordar los mandatos de Dios y de la Iglesia, de nuestra presencia y participación en la Iglesia, de la forma como respondemos a la palabra de Dios con nuestras vidas, nuestra conversión y nuestro compromiso de ayudar a evangelizar nuestra propia familia.

Todo esto nos lleva a escuchar en nuestra Diócesis de Raleigh que necesitamos ser solidarios, activos, con respuestas generosas, inmediatas y llenas de gozo al contribuir en lo que fortalece la unidad de la Iglesia, el camino de la Evangelización, la comunicación de la vivencia de la caridad en obras solidarias que nos ayuden a vivir todos en la presencia de Cristo y poder decirles a todos: “Este pasaje de la Escritura se ha cumplido al escucharlo hoy ustedes”

Como signo de nuestra comunión con la Iglesia, para construir la unidad y promover la participación se nos pide en este tiempo contribuir con nuestra parroquia, participar en ella, ayudar y contribuir generosamente con la colecta anual del Obispo, BAA y participar en el Sínodo de los Obispos dando nuestra participación y nuestras observaciones a lo que nos piden.

Dear parishioners, with the spirit of starting a new year and with the intention of progressing in the revelation that the Sunday readings make to our community: last week's Scripture revealed to us the Eternal Father wanting to marry his people, Israel; the Holy Spirit animating all the charisms in each person; and the Son of God, revealing His Glory at the wedding at Cana.

Today, consequently, the joy that accompanies listening to the Word of God is revealed to us as the gift of being a living part of the "Body of Christ" and of receiving, by the grace of the Holy Spirit, Christ the Word who works in hearts and in the life of communities as the Good News of salvation. All while bringing teaching, wisdom, healing, interpretation, comfort, and strength to the whole Body of Christ.

But we could be left comparing the Church to a body and our participation as members of that same body with the grace of the Holy Spirit who calls different ministries, different functions to think about what we like about the Church. To think about what God wants and we have not even thought. To think about how we would like the Church to change and in what today has confused so many people who seek to return to the antiquity of the rites, of the prohibitions, and consequently away from the personal relationship with God and with the Church.

Today, we could say, God calls us to live our faith in an authentic, determined, committed way. In the unity of the Church. In the commitment to be an active part in communion with the pastors of the Church. In the experience of the Spirit who encourages us all to function in love and charity, in truth and in justice, in humility and holiness. In the joy of a prayer that becomes life and in works that strengthen mercy, charity, and solidarity.

We could think about the fruits of our prayers, of our Sunday celebrations, of the reception of the sacraments, of the times we dedicate to Bible study, of remembering the commands of God and the Church, of our presence and participation in the Church, of the way we respond to the Word of God with our lives, our conversion, and our commitment to help evangelize our own family.

All this leads us to hear in our Diocese of Raleigh that we need to be supportive and active with generous, immediate, and joyful responses. We need to be contributing to what strengthens the unity of the Church; the path of Evangelization, the communication of the experience of charity in works of solidarity helping us all live in the presence of Christ and to be able to say to all: "*This passage of Scripture has been fulfilled as you hear it today*".

As a sign of our communion with the Church and to build unity and promote participation, we are also asked at this time to contribute to our parish, participate in it, help it, and contribute generously to the Annual Collection of the Bishop (BAA) and participate in the Synod of Bishops by giving our participation and our observations to what they ask of us.

Let us be the Living Body of Christ!!!


