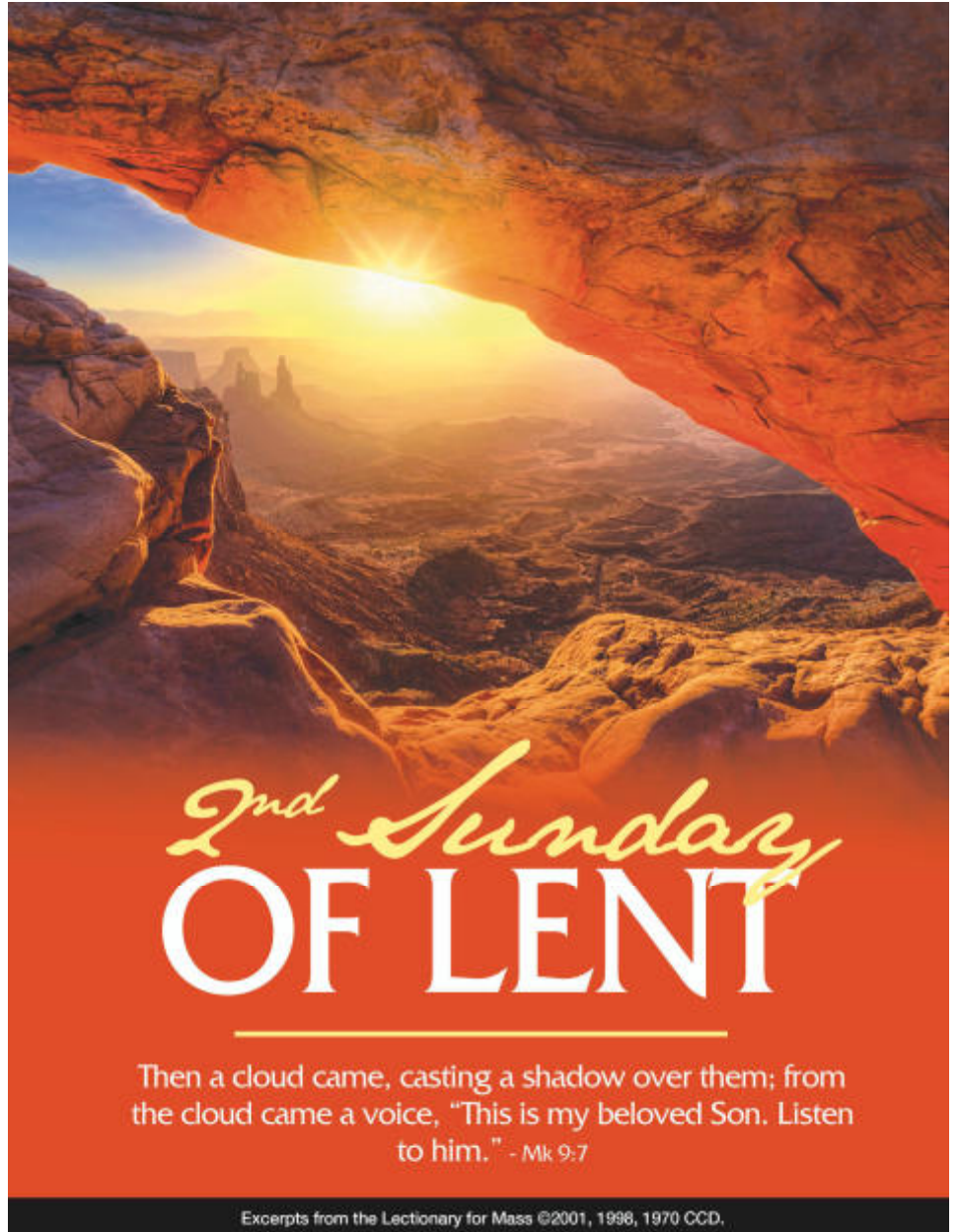

This will be a drive through with a set menu. Fried fish only, baked potato, cole slaw, and hush puppies, all for only \$8. Call ahead to reserve your dinners starting the Monday prior to the Friday Fish Fry at 529-4982. Dinners will be brought out to your car; you will not need to come in. **STATIONS OF THE CROSS** are every Friday at 7:00 pm here at OLPH during Lent. Different versions of the stations will be led by various groups in the church each Friday.

**NEXT WEEKEND MARCH 6th AND 7th**, we will have a stud from the site where the "Apostle Build" for Habitat for Humanity will be built. Normally the parish would be invited to come to the site and raise the first wall along with the other churches involved in the built. Since these are different times with restrictions, Patrick and Susan Moore will bring a stud from the site that will be painted and be for OLPH. They will have it out in the parking lot after the Masses on the weekend of March 6/7 and on Tuesday, March 9th from 10:00 am to 12:00 pm in the pavilion as well on March 12th in the pavilion when pick-up for the Fish Fry is going on. Anyone from the parish that would like to is invited to come and sign the stud by signing their name, a blessing, a scripture verse, etc.. The stud will then be returned to the site to be placed with all the others, twenty two altogether from all the different churches, and will be used in the first walls raised for the house. Pictures will be taken and you will be able to see the stud OLPH signed by the color.

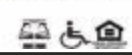
