**STATIONS OF THE CROSS** are every Friday at 7:00 pm here at OLPH during Lent. Different versions of the stations will be led by various groups in the church each Friday.

**HABITAT FOR HUMANITY** Stop by the Pavilion on Tuesday, March 9th from 10:00 am to 12:00 pm or on March 12th from 4:30 to 6:00 pm and sign the stud to be used in the house being built by volunteers from OLPH and 22 other churches. Signing either your name, a blessing, a scripture verse, etc.. The stud will then be returned to the site to be placed with all the others, and will be used in the first walls raised for the house. Pictures will be taken and you will be able to see the stud OLPH signed by the color.

**THE FORTY DAYS OF LIFE CAMPAIGN IS ON!** The campaign goes from February 17th – March 28th. What is 40 Days for Life? 40 Days for Life is an internationally coordinated 40-day campaign that aims to end abortion locally through prayer and fasting, community outreach, and a peaceful all-day vigil in front of Planned Parenthood. OLPH has been assigned Tuesdays to pray in front of Planned Parenthood in Roanoke. The time is from 7am-6 pm. ## OLPH HAS TWO NEW VOLUNTEERS FOR INTERFAITH MINISTRIES

We welcome Geralynn Trelue who has volunteered to be the coordinator of our Family Promise ministry. As you may know, Family Promise is an interfaith ministry that provides housing and meals to families that have become homeless. Many families are only a pay check away from losing their home and it only takes an illness, or a pandemic, or losing their job to put them on the street. Families are given hope and a hand up through counseling, money management and other tools to become self-sustaining once again. In the past OLPH has provided shelter and meals four times a year, helping families to get on their feet. Since the pandemic, families are being sheltered at apartments. By the end of 2021 or beginning of 2022, Family Promise plans to return to their prior plan. OLPH will still provide meals and supplies during the pandemic. Keep posted for ways you might be able to help.

Norman Atta is serving as the project manager for our Habitat for Humanity's Apostle Build. This is also an interfaith ministry, and we will be working with 22 other faith denominations, to build a house for a family in Roanoke. Many parishioners have stepped up to help with this build and looks forward to assisting with future builds.

A big thank you to both of these parishioners and to all our volunteers that help to advance the mission of our Church in spreading the gospel message and living out our call to serve those in need.
