church. Please pick them up as soon as you can.

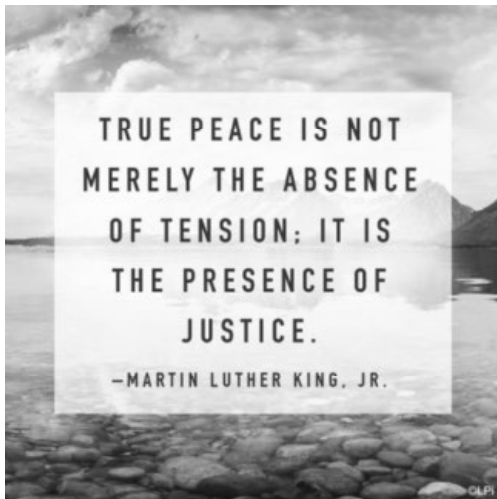

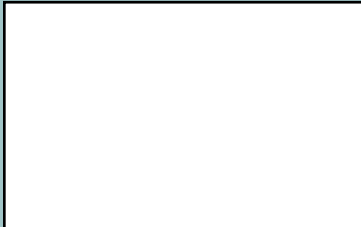

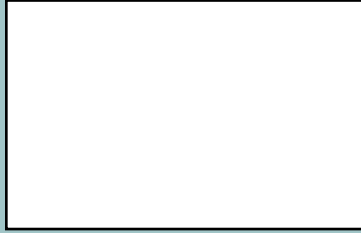
