WORLDWIDE SYNOD

Pope Francis has called for a worldwide synod on synodality (the process of assuring that all "views (especially the marginalized) are respected and heard) in 2023. The purpose of the synod is to allow a dialogue for allowing the Church to better listen and articulate the *sensus fidelium*, or the consensus of the faithful on various topics, which the Church teaches. There will be "listening sessions beginning this coming Advent and parishioners from all parishes are encouraged to participate. There is a need for facilitators to conduct listening sessions. If you are willing to participate, please contact the office. This process will be concluded (on the diocesan level) in March 2022 in preparation for the worldwide synod in 2023.

Staff members live in community with the women to provide support. Beside housing and food, Zelig's Home provides its resident with life skills, education, job placement and counseling.
