



Faith Moment Reflection

Today we celebrate the Feast of the Holy Family of Jesus, Mary and Joseph. The gospel tells of the Holy Family's trip to Jerusalem to present the child, Jesus, to the Lord in the temple. Their story is of a seemingly simple, everyday man and woman that God calls to a sacred role through the sanctity of the family. Mary was a poor peasant. Joseph, a hardworking carpenter. Yet they were asked to be the parents of Jesus. It is a reminder that God calls all of us to holiness amidst our everyday lives. As he did with Mary and Joseph, God asks us to be the caretakers of what he has begun in Christ Jesus.
