**Sacrament of Matrimony:** Arrangements made at least six months prior to date requested. Contact the rectory before setting the date. Preparation classes required.

**Sacrament of the Sick:** Call to make arrangements if chronically ill; prior to entering the hospital. Please notify the parish office if you or a family member is in the hospital, or desire to have the community's prayers.



**TWENTY-FIFTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME**

Being made in the image of God doesn't mean only our personal existence, but also treating other in a God-like way.

The unjust steward can be viewed as having a similar attitude. He knows his strengths and weaknesses and uses them to help himself and others. He learns that when we are good to others, they do good to us. That worldly wisdom is not necessarily opposed to living as children of the light. By living the Golden Rule, we can also serve God. St. Paul

exhorts his hearers to pray for those in authority. By so doing we take on the mind and heart of God to support and challenge our leaders. Both support and challenge serve God and Jesus Christ, the mediator between God and humanity.

Our "Golden Rule" is to do unto others as God does unto us: love with mercy, care for the poor and outcast, and learn God's ways to live God's ways. At a meeting with families in Manila, Pope Francis reminded people that faith does not take us away from (or out of) the world but challenges us to participate more fully in it. When we take on the mind and heart of God, we live our faith by using our flesh and blood to serve God and all God's people, whether physically or spiritually poor, or both. Do not trample upon the poor and needy. Do unto them as God does unto all.

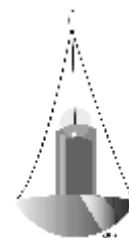
