

### FROM OUR PASTOR

In today's Gospel, Jesus slips away from the family caravan and does not tell Mary and Joseph that he is leaving. Like many parents, they keenly felt the anxiety of family life. They search for 3 days looking for Jesus.

When they find him in the temple, Mary speaks up: *"Why have you done this to us?"* She goes on to explain that they have been looking for Him for 3 days. Jesus replies that they should have realized that He would be in **"His Father's house**". Mary and Joseph did not understand Jesus' response.

I wonder how many parents do not understand their children at times. I wonder how many children have said "*Mom and Dad, you just don't understand.*" Parents have to walk the fine line of instilling discipline and responsibility and then very gradually letting go of control. Eventually, letting go altogether. This is no easy task. Rubbing shoulders everyday with family is not always easy either. Family life demands love, loyalty, respect, reverence, self-denial and generosity. The Holy Family is a model for us amid the fears and difficulties of family life. A happy home is not made of bricks and mortar. **A happy home has its foundation in Christ.**

### **The Familial Journey Advances**

Today we are given an intimate look into the workings of Jesus' earthly family. This is a challenging ride for all of us; whether we are parents or we had/have parents. We know that this relationship changes over time and presents new and interesting circumstances for us to ponder. There are not many words from Mary in the gospels but today we hear her astonished question, "Son, why have you done this to us?" We have Jesus' answer but then the gospel goes on to say "they did not understand what he said to them." This interaction sounds very human. We are told in the second reading that we should "let the peace of Christ control your hearts." There is a choice here and we strive, and will probably continue to strive, to "let the word of Christ dwell (in us) richly."

The day after Christmas is known as "Boxing Day" in many countries. My husband is from England and I used to joke about it being the day to let off all the pent up tension from the Christmas preparations. The day actually revolves around emptying the Church Alms boxes and distributing the funds or food/items bought with the funds to those in need of aid. I do not know how widely it is practiced anymore but I like the idea of opening our "boxes" and distributing our gifts-physical or spiritual with "gratitude in our hearts to God."


