## From Our Pastor

**Dear Friends,**

I wanted to update you on some items surrounding Holy Communion. As you know, we have not been distributing the Precious Blood since the pandemic started. At this time, we will not be bringing it back. The issue comes with

how much Precious Blood to consecrate and whether people are willing to consume the remaining Precious Blood after a number of people have shared a common chalice. With flu season coming up and people still being cautious about Covid, it doesn't seem like the time to bring the distribution of the Precious Blood back.

This has caused an issue for those who are gluten intolerant since they cannot receive Holy Communion. Beginning now, we will have low gluten hosts (0.01 ppm) consecrated in the tabernacle. They are individually wrapped so people do not have to worry about cross contamination. At each Mass, the presider will put a few of these individually wrapped consecrated low gluten hosts in each paten so you should just have to go up to the communion minister and indicate that you need a low gluten host. You would then unwrap the consecrated host, receive communion and place the wrapper back in the paten. We will then dispose of the wrapper appropriately in case of any particles. We hope this will be helpful for anyone dealing with Celiac Disease or who has issues with gluten.

Next weekend is Commitment Weekend for our annual stewardship campaign. As I have indicated, we have two forms this year - one

for treasure (offertory) and one for time and talent. Please prayerfully fill out both and be ready to bring them up before the altar during Mass next weekend. I am so grateful for all of you and your generosity towards our parish. We simply cannot do it without you and your love and commitment to our parish is truly remarkable and a blessing.

## Have you played or officiated basketball?

The Catholic Youth Organization (CYO) is seeking prospective officials for its grade school basketball program. Games will be played in various Catholic parish/school gyms each Saturday (8:30am-5:00pm) and Sunday (1:00pm-7:00pm) December through early March.

### Four training sessions will be held. Prospective officials are asked to attend all four:

Sundays, November 7<sup>th</sup>, 14<sup>th</sup>, & 21<sup>st</sup> and Sunday, December 1<sup>st</sup> at St. Francis de Sales High School for a shift in an on-court situation. The 7<sup>th</sup> & 21<sup>st</sup> class will be held at the CYO Office at 6:00pm (1933 Spielbusch Avenue in downtown Toledo) and the

class on the 14<sup>th</sup> will be held at Sylvania St. Joseph Parish in the east campus gym. Many CYO officials also play on their high school freshmen, junior varsity and/or varsity squads. As long as CYO is provided with a schedule of games, we will schedule around your basketball conflicts.

You must submit to the CYO Office completed W-4 and I-9 forms (and required documents), as well as a Certificate of Completion from the free online NFHS Concussion Awareness Class to fulfill Ohio House Bill 143 before you may be paid for working in the CYO program.

Officials younger than 16 years old will be paid Ohio minimum wage of \$7.25/hour.

Officials older than 16 will be paid at least \$8.55/hour (increases to \$9.30/hour on 1.1.22) depending on experience.
