A blessed and happy New Year to all of you! We as Catholics bring in the new year in the best way possible - by dedicating it to Mary, Mother of God on January 1. We ask our Blessed Mother to watch over us and to be with us throughout 2022! I wanted to update you on a number of items.

- 1) We now have possession of the house across the street that we intend to use as a convent in the future. 5) Our Coordinator of Youth Ministry, Haley Augustyniak, has decided to step down from her role. We are in the process of looking for a new youth minister. Haley did amazing ministry in the short time she was here and we appreciate her!

We continue to see monumental growth in our youth and young adult ministries as well as new ministries being formed for young-ish adults!!! I was truly edified to see how many people made use of the Sacrament of Confession throughout the Advent season. And I love that our Masses are so lively and filled with such great faithfulness!

I know that 2022 is going to be an awesome year for St. Joe's! I am grateful for everyone who took part in our feasibility study as we look towards a capital campaign. Stay tuned for exciting things as we look to continue to grow as a parish and school!


