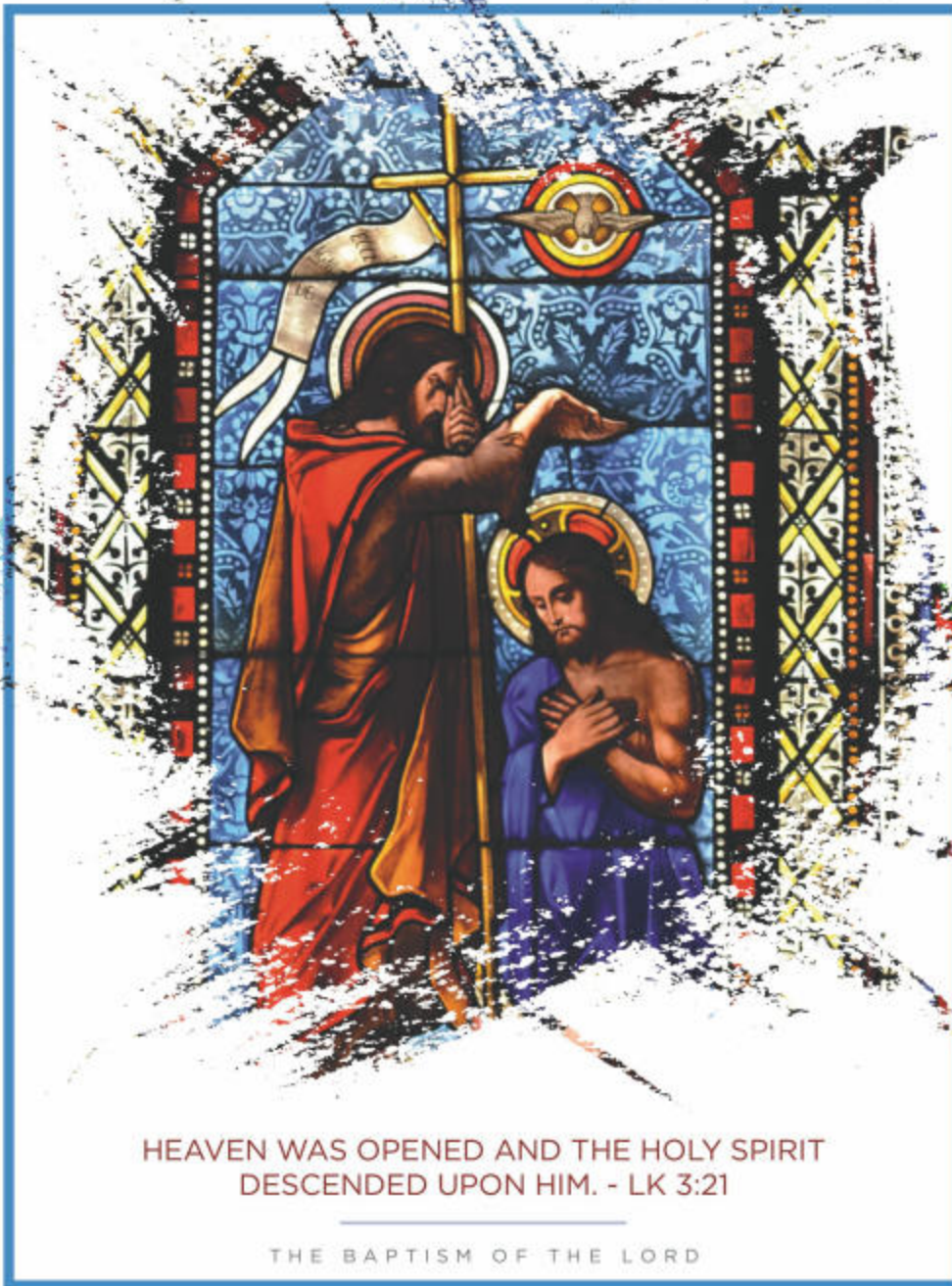

Dear Friends,

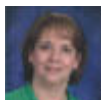
