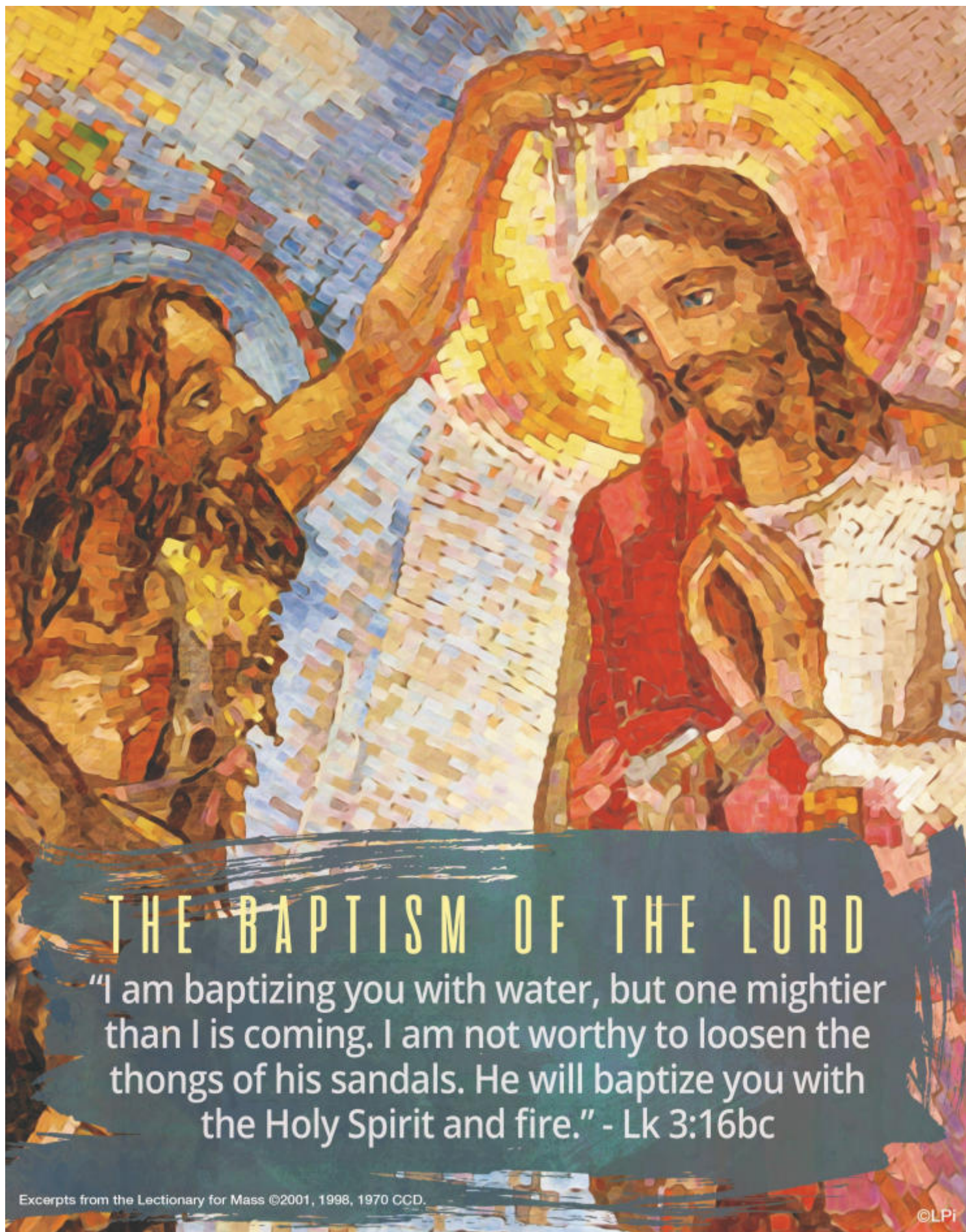

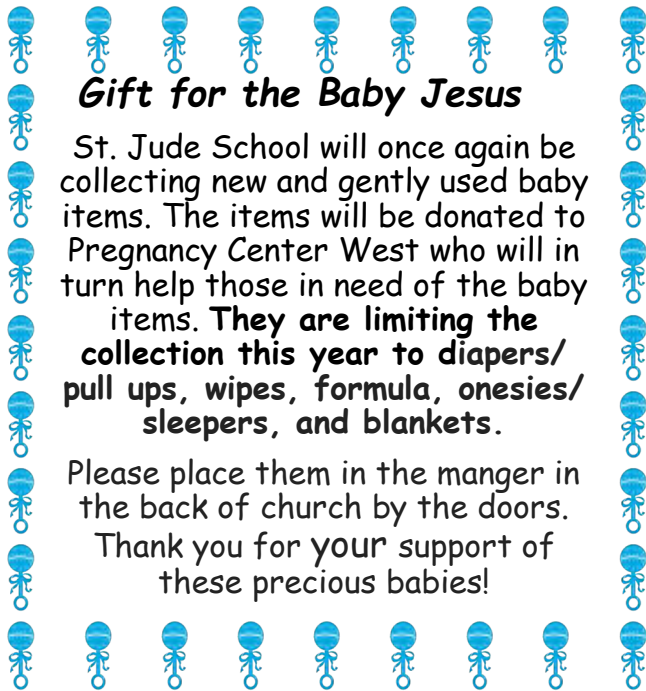

## RESPECT LIFE

**Respect Life - Baptism and Life:** “Whoever is moved by love begins to perceive what “life” really is. He begins to perceive the meaning of the word of hope that we encountered in the Baptismal Rite: from faith I await “eternal life” - the true life which, whole and unthreatened, in all its fullness, is simply life. Jesus, who said that he had come so that we might have life and have it in its fullness, in abundance (cf. Jn 10:10), has also explained to us what “life” means: “this is eternal life, that they know you the only true God, and Jesus Christ whom you have sent” (Jn 17:3). Life in its true sense is not something we have exclusively in or from ourselves: it is a relationship. And life in its totality is a relationship with him who is the source of life. If we are in relation with him who does not die, who is Life itself and Love itself, then we are in life. Then we ‘live’” – Pope Benedict XVI, Encyclical on Hope, November 30, 2007. 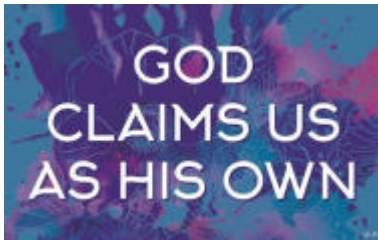

### MONTH FOUR - - *Developing Baby Spiritual Adoption Program*

**“I had a dream!”** Your baby’s brain has begun maturing – a process that will continue until she is about 14 years old. Her eyelids are now sealed and will re-open at 7 months. Her taste buds are now working. Nutrients consumed by her mother are passed on to her within an hour or two. Three hundred quarts of fluid a day are sent to the baby via the umbilical cord. Fine hair begins to grow on head, eyebrows and eyelashes. Facial expressions similar to parents of the baby can be seen at this time. This month REMS (rapid eye movements) have been recorded – a sign of dreaming. Your baby is now about 9 inches in length. Thank you for praying!

### **Softball Signups for 2022 now open!**

St. Jude softball offers a fun and welcoming environment for girls in grades K-8 to grow in skill, sportsmanship and spirit. Softball for grades K-2<sup>nd</sup> is coach pitch (instructional) and typically practice once a week. Grades 3<sup>rd</sup>-4<sup>th</sup> are modified fast pitch with practices twice per week. Grades 5<sup>th</sup>-8<sup>th</sup> are fast pitch and practice twice per week. Practices will begin in late March (weather permitting) with games starting in late April. **The Cincinnati Western Baseball Conference (CWBC)** is seeking umpires for the 2022 baseball season. The CWBC season runs from March 26, 2022 through the end of June. Umpire training classes are scheduled to be held on the Saturday mornings of February 26, March 5 and March 12 from 9:00am – 12:00pm at Our Lady of Victory cafeteria. On-field sessions are scheduled for March 18, 19 and 20 at Our Lady of Visitation fields. Umpires must be at least a freshman in high school and have reliable transportation to and from games. No prior experience as an umpire is required, but a working knowledge of baseball is strongly recommended. New umpires are required to attend each of the three classroom sessions and at least one of the on-field sessions. Returning umpires are encouraged to attend the classroom sessions and the on-field sessions. The cost for the training is \$20 for new umpires. New umpires will be responsible for purchasing their umpire apparel and gear. Umpire fees will start at \$40 per game for the 2022 season. **Holy Hour for the Protection of the Unborn**



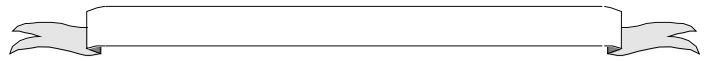
**2022 Cincinnati Men's Conference**

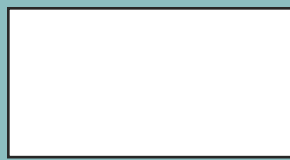
