My brothers and sisters in Christ:

Soon the anniversary of Roe vs. Wade will have passed and there will have been marches and prayers for the restoration of the right to life for the unborn.

As we well know, the abortion issue is a very contentious one here in our nation. It has been politicized to the point that neither side hears what the other is saying. In my opinion, there is little hope for the unborn as long as abortion remains a political stickpin.

Prayer and example are the best ways to combat this sin. Prayer and penance are God’s tools that we can use to try to influence society as a whole to reject the very idea of abortion. Charity towards those who disagree with us is the example we must set so that we might encourage others to listen to our pleas on behalf of respect for all life. “As a bridegroom rejoices in his bride, so shall your God rejoice in you.” Today’s first reading from Isaiah shows us how much God delights in human life. He rejoices in us as in a bride. He gives himself to us as a bridegroom is called to do for his beloved. He protects and defends us, and leads us to the life that never ends. His commitment to humanity is the source of ours. Like him, we are to give ourselves for the good of others, starting with the most vulnerable lives – children at the very beginning of their development in the womb. Moreover, this coincides with our nation’s honoring of Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr., whose dream of equality for all under the law needs to be applied now to the children in the womb. **Boys Baseball and Volleyball Sign-ups Now Open:** These signups are available until the end of the month. After that a late fee of \$25 will be charged and roster spots will depend on availability. <https://tshq.bluesombrero.com/Default.aspx?tabid=1478434>

**Baseball Signups for 2021 Season:** Signups are now open for the 2022 baseball season. We need to have the number of teams identified by the age balance by the February 19, 2022 for levels 8U and up. Please sign up now on Blue Sombrero ([Home](#)). The levels of sign-ups are based on age. So depending on where your child's age falls should depend on the level they play.

**Signups** for the following 3 levels will run until February 19, 2022. The cost for these levels will be \$50. 5U has to be 5 years old or younger by May 1st, 2021 (this is Tee Ball); 6U has to be 6 years old or younger by May 1st, 2022 (this is 1st year of Coaches Pitch); 7U has to be 7 years old or younger by May 1st, 2022 (2nd year of **Coaches Pitch**).

**Signups** for the following 5 levels will run until February 19, 2022. The cost for these levels will be \$65 (all these levels are kids pitch). 8U has to be 8 years old or younger by May 1st, 2022; 9U has to be 9 years old or younger by May 1st, 2022; 11U has to be 11 years old or younger by May 1st, 2022; 13U has to be 13 years old or younger by May 1st, 2022 15U has to be 15 years old or younger by May 1st, 2022.

**The Cincinnati Western Baseball Conference (CWBC)** is seeking umpires for the 2022 baseball season. The CWBC season runs from March 26, 2022 through the end of June. Umpire training classes are scheduled to be held on the Saturday mornings of February 26, March 5 and March 12 from 9:00am – 12:00pm at Our Lady of Victory cafeteria. On-field sessions are scheduled for March 18, 19 and 20 at Our Lady of Visitation fields. Umpires must be at least a freshman in high school and have reliable transportation to and from games. No prior experience as an umpire is required, but a working knowledge of baseball is strongly recommended. New umpires are required to attend each of the three classroom sessions and at least one of the on-field sessions. 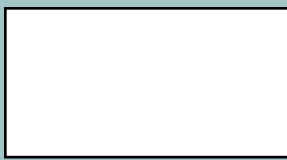
