**Liturgical Reflection:**

**30th Sunday in Ordinary Time**

As Christian stewards we are called to devote a regular portion of our time to God in prayer. Perhaps we find it intimidating to find the right words. Today's Gospel shows us we don't need to have our "act together" before we can spend time with Him.

Bartimaeus received a powerful answer to prayer at a very low point in his life. His prayer was desperate, it was a sincere cry from his heart. He experienced a profound moment of personal encounter with our Lord and the healing of his vision he desired, right there on the spot.

How simple it is to encounter Jesus! So let us take courage and use our time this week knowing that Jesus is calling us right now to spend time with Him just as we are, in all our weakness and brokenness. Tell Him the great High priest, what your needs are and then like Bartimaeus, follow him, and keep on living your stewardship way of life. It's a life with the ultimate happy ending.
