STEWARDSHIP MOMENT: THE TWENTY-SECOND SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

In the Gospel & the first reading this week, there is an emphasis on humility. Sirach writes, "conduct your affairs with humility." In Psalm 68, the psalmist proclaims, "God gives a home to the forsaken." In the Gospel, Jesus reminds us that we should not seek the best seat at the banquet table. This is not merely a lesson in manners, but a challenge to check our egos at the door. A good steward lives and serves as if he or she serves Jesus. Serving with humility does not require payback or recognition. Good stewards are humbly aware of the source of their gifts and share generously without counting the cost. In this parable Jesus challenges us to see ourselves differently. You might reflect on whether you see yourself as better than those who are in need.


