## Gospel Reflection

At the heart of this weekend's Gospel invitation is a longing in Jesus' heart that we rest from those burdens which weigh us down unnecessarily. It's true that there are many good things God calls us to do that can exhaust us. But this "holy exhaustion" is not a bad thing. In fact, being "exhausted" by the will of God actually deepens our faith and fills us with joy. And that joy lightens our burden. The main reason for our need to "come away" and "rest" is that there are many things in life that are not part of God's will. These are burdens we impose upon ourselves unnecessarily. These burdens, more than anything else, are what we need to rest from. Reflect, today, upon how ready and willing you are to accept the invitation from Jesus to come and rest with and in Him. Commit yourself to doing just that. Make the choice, today, to find time to be alone. From that time of solitude, seek the still, small and silent voice of God. Let the quiet and the peace of God's presence bring clarity and focus to your busy life.

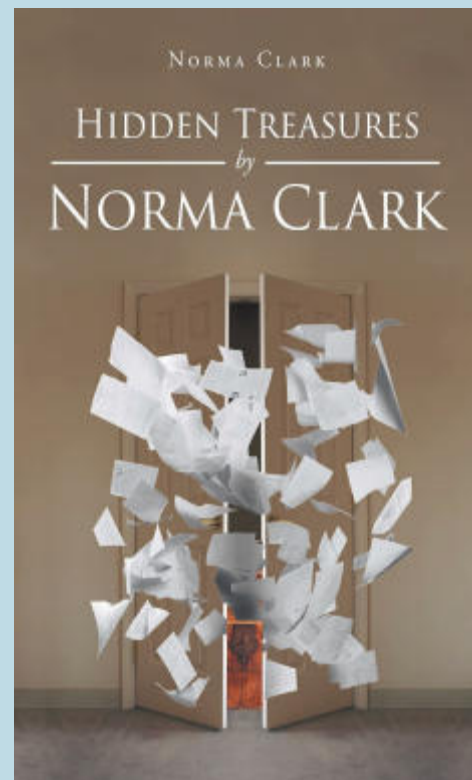
