Gospel Reflection

Reflecting on the scriptures

Do you consider yourself gifted? I don't mean blessed. I mean, do you think you have gifts to share with others?

In today's second reading we hear that the Spirit has given each person different gifts, gifts to be used in service. The examples given in the reading, the gift of prophecy, the gift of tongues are unusual enough to lead you to think you have no gifts at all. But the scripture argues that you do. Maybe, instead of looking at the list in Corinthians it would be helpful to look inside yourself.

Can you listen, really listen...with empathy...to others? Can you speak words of encouragement to strengthen others? Are you brave and willing to take risks, to lead others to accept a challenge? Are you a visionary who can see possibilities that others may not see? Those, and many more, are gifts too, given by the Spirit.

In today's gospel, the story of the wedding feast at Cana, Jesus miraculously changes water into wine. But note... he does start with water. He doesn't change wine out of nothing! The servers bring to him six stone jars full of water. From that, the gospel says, he makes the best wine at the feast.

I suggest that those gifts we each have are like the water in those jars. Given to the Lord they become so much more, a source of joy and well-being for others. Those gifts were not given to us to linger unused, but instead were given to us to be used to build up the kingdom of God.

If that is true then learning what our gifts are is not a simple personality quiz, but a spiritual practice. And fine-tuning them and offering them to others in service is nothing less than following the directive of Mary to the servants, "Do whatever he tells you."

Our own parish will be offering the "Called by the Spirit" workshop on Saturday, April 30. This would be a great opportunity to learn more about your gifts. You will even be able to participate on-line! Watch for publicity in the bulletin as the time draws near.
