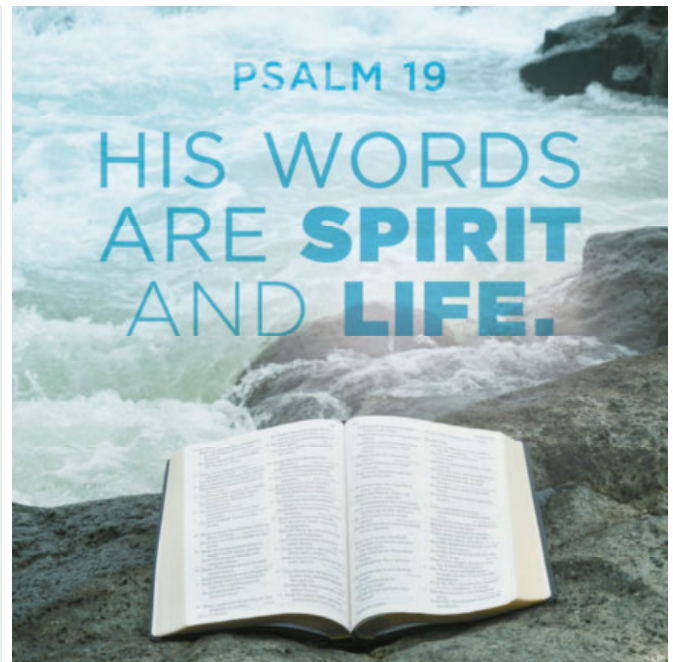

Gospel Reflection

Reflecting on the scriptures

In today's gospel we hear Jesus state his mission as he understands it: "To proclaim liberty to captives, recovery of sight to the blind and to let the oppressed go free." And then, very significantly he says, "Today this scripture passage is fulfilled in your hearing." The in-breaking of the reign of God has begun, he says. It sounds so hopeful.

Is that how you're feeling? I know I am having trouble feeling hopeful. The ongoing pandemic, the tribalism that is separating us into opposing camps...it all can sap one's optimism.

And yet, I am reminded by the gospel that the Christian it's not called to optimism. We are called to hope. Hope that God is indeed working in the world even if it is difficult to see. And we are called to participate in that work by participating in the mission of Jesus, the work of confronting oppression, the work of justice.

I think support for that directive can be found in today's second reading, Paul's emphasis that we are part of one body. Just as one part of the body cannot say to any other part, "I have no need of you," so we cannot say to others, "I have no need of you." We cannot say nor can our behavior demonstrate that we think we have "no need" of the homeless person, the incarcerated person, the immigrant at our border, the sick person without health care, the people living in communities without safe drinking water...The welfare of others is our concern. The teaching and the example of Jesus direct us away from selfish concern for our own individual welfare, our "rights", to a concern for the whole body.

And when we follow the example of Jesus I think hope is possible. After all, he was hopeful. Even near the end of his life, entrusting his mission to his followers, he was hopeful. God's kingdom would come. God's will would be done...with God's grace and the work of his followers.
